

RESOLUTION No. 15 for 1915.

Providing for the Widening of Oak Street.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON, OREGON:

That, whereas the Common Council deems it expedient and for the best interests of said City that Oak Street be widened to the full width of sixty (60) feet, at all places therein between the East line of Main Street and the East line of River Street at which it is now less than said width; therefore,

The City Engineer of said City is hereby authorized and directed to make a survey and plat of said proposed changes and extensions of width of said Oak Street, to mark the boundaries thereof, and to make and file with the City Recorder, within twenty (20) days from the date of this resolution, a written report containing a full and complete description of such street and proposed changes, the boundaries thereof, and the portions of each lot and tract of land to be appropriated therefor; also to file said plat with said Recorder.

Adopted by unanimous vote of the Council this 20th day of April, 1915.
