Resolution No. 18 for 1915.

APPOINTING VIEWERS, IN THE MATTER OF EXTENDING
AND WIDENING OAK STREET FROM MAIN
STREET TO RIVER STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON, OREGON:

That, in pursuance of Ordinance No. 194, passed
and approved on the 4th day of May, 1915, providing for the
extension and widening of Oak Street, and in pursuance of
Section 178 of the City Charter, M. O. McClain,
J. S. Northrop, and D. A. Kendall, disinterested
freeholders of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, having the quali-
fications of jurors of the Circuit Court of Linn County, Oregon,
are hereby appointed Viewers, to view said street and the pro-
posed changes and extension thereof, and to make an assessment
of damages and benefits as provided by Article I of Chapter VIII
of the City Charter.

And be it further resolved that said viewers shall
meet at the office of the City Attorney in said City at 2:00
o'clock P. M. on the 20th day of July, 1915, for the purpose of
hearing evidence and making such assessment, and that due notice
of such meeting be given as provided by Section 178 of the said
City Charter.
