RESOLUTION 3 FOR 1917

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN A. I. CRANDALL.

RESOLVED BY the common council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon that there is on file with the recorder of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, a petition for the improvement of Ash Street from the East line of Main Street to the East line of Allin Street and for the Improvement of Vine street from the East line of Main Street to the East-line of Williams Street, and for the from the South line of Vine improvement of Williams Street Grant Street to the North line of D. K street, and the impovements to be known and designated as the Ash Street Distruct in the City of Lebanon, Oregon. The said Improvements to be in the following manner.

1.- By grading the said streets to proper sun grade. 2.- By constructing proper drainage for the said streets By graveling the road way of sthe said streets to a width 3.not exceeding twelve feet, and of sufficient thickness to make a thorough fare of good condition for trafic all to consist of not more than three all the year, the same courses of crushed gravel .

4.-By robling the same when spread on the said road way with a ten ton roller so that the same will be compact. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the said Council that the said council ascertained and determined from the said petition now on file in said matter with the recorder of the said City that the said petition is signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the abutting real property on each of the said streets to be so improbed and by the owners of more than a of all the real property abutting upon or specially majority benefited by the said proposed improvements of the said streets as a whole District.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED By the said Council that the said petition asks and petitions that the same be made at onesh and that No notice of the intention to make the said improvement be given by publication or other wise to the owners
