RESOLUTION μ 4 FOR 1917

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN A. I. CRANDALL.

RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON. That the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, deems it expedient and for the best interest of the said City of Lebanon and its inhabitants to improve certain streets in the said city, and it appearing to the council that there is on file with the recorder of the said City, and now before the Council a petition duly signed by the owners of a magority of all the real property abutting upon and specially benefited by the said proposed improvement of the said streets, and after due investigation, the said council ascertains and determines that the said petition is so signed by the owners a more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon and specially benefitted by the improvement of the said streets mentioned and described in the said petition, which said proposed improvement is for the following streets and to be made as follows, to-wit:-Ash street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Hiatt Street.

Vine Street from the East line of Main Street to the East line of William Street.

William Street from the South line Vine Street to the Grant North line of Ech/street, the said improvements to be designated and known as the Ash street District. and as follows :-By grading the said streets to proper sub grade. 1.-By Constructing proper drainage for the said streets. 2.thercad way of By graveling the said streets with CCrushed gravel to a width of not more than twelve feet and of sufficient 3.depth to make a thorough fare of good condition for trafic all the year, the same to consist of not more than three inches coarse gravel over laid with not more than three inches fine gravel.

4.- By rolling the same with a ten ton roller to make the same compact.

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The said improvement to be made and done in accordance with Stricle IV of the charter of the city of Lebanon, and suth other provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and the ordinances of the said City and the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act", and in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Street Superintendent, of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, acting as City Engeneer of the said City, filed in the office of the _ecorder of the City of Lebanon, on the 5th day of Octiber, 1917, and Endorsed "Plans and Specification and stimates for the Improvement of Ash Street District, in the City of Lebanon, Oregon,"

That the Cost of the Grading of the said Streets, and the cost 12 of the construction of the drainage of the said streets and the 13 cost of the rolling of the same when the gravel of spread thereand the cost of the improvement of the intersection thereof on, with any street to be paid by the City of Lebanon, Oregon, out of the general funds of the said city or the street and bridge fund or any other funds of the said city available for that purpose, and that the remaining portion of the said cost of the improvements of the said said streets and District be paid by the owners of the abutting property and the property specially benefitted thereby, and that the same be assessed upon and against the said abutting real property and property specially benefitsed thereby as provided by the charter of the said city and the ordinances thereif and the laws of the State of Oregon.

That the City Street Superintendent acting as city engineer estimates of the probable toal cost of the said improvement for the whole district now on file in this matter is as follows :-Estimates for the probable total cost of the said improvement \$1710.00 for the whole district,

Estimates for the probable total cost of the whole district to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the

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real property specially benefitted thereby is \$1140.00

Estimates of the probable total costs of the said improvement of the whole district to be paid by the City of Lebanon 1s \$570.00 That the estimates of the ;probable total costs for the

said improvement for the several streets are as follows :--

ASH STRENT

Estimate for the probable total cost of the said improvement of Ash street is \$720.00

Estimate of the probable total cost of the said improvement of ash street to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and real property specially benefitted thereby is \$480.00

Estimate of the probable total cost of the said improvement of ash street to be paid by the city of LBanon is \$240.00

VINE STREET.

The estimate of the probable total cost of the said improvement of Vine streets is \$540.00

Estimate of the probable total cost of the said improvement of Vine street to be paid by the owners of the bautting real pp property and real property specially benefitted by the said improvement is \$360.00.

The estimate of the probable total costs of the improvement of said Vine street to be paid by the city of Lebanon is \$150.00 WILLIAMS STREET

The estimate of the probable total cost on the said improvement of said Williams Street is \$450.00

The estimate of the probable total cost of the said Willaims street to be paid by the onwers of the abutting real property and treal property specially benefittedt thereby is \$300.00

The estimate of the probable total cost of the improvement of said Williams Street to be paid by the City of _Lebanon, is \$150.00.

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That the plans and specification and estimates of the said City Street Superintendent of the City of Lebanon, acting as city engineer, now on file in the office of the Redorder of the said City for the improvement of the said streets known as the Ash Street District being as follows: Ash Street from the East line of Main Street to the East line of William Street t in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and Vine Street from the East Line of Main Street to the Fast Line of Williams Street, and Williams Street from the South line of Vine Street to the North Grant Line of En/ Street. the said improvement to be made as herein provided and as provided in the said petition on file herein and according to the said plans and specifications now on file for the said improvement. And that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby in all things approved. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in as much as thereis on file with the recorder of the City of Lebanon, Ofegon, a petition signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement and the real property specially benefitted thereby, that no further notice be given of the intention of the said city to the said proposed improvement as prayed for in said pemake tition and estimates.
