

RESOLUTION NO. 3 FOR 1918

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN A. I. CRANDALL.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, deem it for the best interest of the said City and its inhabitants to amend the Charter of the said City to make the same conform to the general laws of the State of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, deem it for the best interest of the said City to amend the said Charter of the said City of Lebanon, fixing the terms of the officers of the said city and the time of holding elections therein to make the same conform to the laws of the State of Oregon, regarding State, County and Municipal elections.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY of Lebanon, Oregon, that the be and is hereby submitted to the legal voters of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, to be voted on at the general election to be held in said city on ~~Tuesday~~ ~~Following~~ the first Monday in November 1918, the same being the 5th day of November, 1918, the following amendments to the Charter of the said City of Lebanon, which said Charter to be amended was duly approved by a majority vote of the legal electors of the said City at the regular election held in the said City of the 1st day of December 1913, to-wit:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE COUNCIL.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 19 of Article I of Chapter II of the Charter of the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, which said charter was duly adopted by a majority of the duly qualified votes cast at the general Election held in the said City on the 1st day of December, 1913 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Section 19: That the City of Lebanon, Kinn County, Oregon, shall hold its nominating and regular election for the election of all the several elective officers at the same time and in

4 Lebanon, Oregon, which said Charter was duly adopted by a  
5 majority of the duly qualified legal votes cast at the gener-  
6 al election held in the said City on the 1st day of December  
7 1913, be and the same is <sup>hereby</sup> amended to read as follows:-

8 Section 36:- The terms of office of the Councilmen shall be  
9 four years, and the terms of office of the mayor, Recorder and  
10 treasurer shall be two years: Provided that the councilmen elect-  
11 ed to office at the regular municipal election on November 1918  
12 the councilman from each ward elected thereat and receiving the  
13 highest number of votes shall hold and continue in office for  
14 the term of four years, and the councilman in each ward elected  
15 and receiving the next highest number of votes at such elect-  
16 tion shall hold and continue in office for the term of two years.  
17 At all succeeding election thereafter there shall be elected one  
18 councilman from each ward whose term of office shall be four  
19 years. The City Marshall, Superintendent of Streets, City Attor-  
20 ney, City Health Office, Pound Master and all other minor of-  
21 ficers of the said city shall be chosen by the council and  
22 hold their <sup>offices</sup> during the pleasure of the Council, and all officers  
23 of the corporation shall be liable to be removed at any time  
24 by the council for malfeasance, neglect or incompetency in office.  
25 In every case officers shall hold their respective offices until  
26 their successors shall have been elected or appointed and shall  
27 have qualified.
