

RESOLUTION NO. 1 FOR 1918.

WHEREAS, The Superintendent of Streets of the City of Lebanon, has reported to the Council of the said City in Writing that a new cement side walk is necessary on the east side of Main Street and abutting lots 3 and 4 in Block 2 in Kirkpatrick's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, The said council finds and ascertains that the walk now abutting upon the said lots is old, and rotten, and of wood construction and is unsafe and in a dangerous condition, and that the same is within the cement district of the said city and provided by Ordinance No. 128 of the said City duly enacted on the 18th day of February, 1918, and

WHEREAS, on account of the dangerous condition of the said walk the same should be built in the shortest time reasonable for that purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.

That the owners of the said Lots 3 and 4 in Block No. 2 in Kirkpatrick's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, build or cause to be built a cement side walk six feet wide and on the established grade on the east side of Main Street in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and abutting upon and against the said lots 3 and 4 in said Block 2 in said Addition within twenty days from the date of this order and resolution, and that the same be built and constructed in accordance with Ordinance No. 74 and said ordinance 128 of the said city, and that the same be built and constructed of cement, sand and gravel as provided in the said ordinance 74, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council ascertains and determined that the owners or reputed owners of the said lots are H. L. Simpson, whose address is 331 Marguerite *Quinn*

4 Be it Further resolved, that the Superintendent of Street of  
5 the said City post a notice upon the said lots as provided  
6 by section 223 of the Charter of the said City, and that  
7 the Recorder of the said City mail notices to each of the  
8 said reputed owners of the said lots as provided by said  
9 section 223 of the charter of the said City of Lebanon.

10 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the said owners of  
11 of the said lots shall fail, neglect or refuse to build  
12 the said sidewalk within the time herein ordered that the *said*  
13 superintendent shall build the same as provided by the  
14 charter of the said city and the ordinances thereof and keep  
15 an accurate account of the cost of labor and material in  
16 the building of such sidewalk in front of each lot or parcel  
17 of land and shall report as soon as completed the cost of  
18 such sidewalk and a description of the lots or part thereof  
19 fronting on the side walk so made, which said report shall  
20 be in writing and filed with the recorder of the City of  
21 Lebanon.
