

RESOLUTION NO. 10 FOR 1919.

Whereas on the 20th day of May, 1919, after due and proper proceedings duly had and done, and upon the petition of a majority of all the abutting property owners and ~~xxxxxxx~~ the owners of a majority of all the abutting property and property specially benefitted thereby by the said improvement, the common council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, did proceed to make and cause to be made the following improvement in and to Isabella Street, as follows:

Isabella Street from the east line of Main Street east to the east line of Lot 7 in Block 5 in Pirkpatrick's Third Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, said improvement to be made as follows:-

- 1st, by grading the said street to proper subgrade
- 2nd, by making proper drainage of the said Street
- 3rd, by graveling the road way of the said street for a width of ten feet with crushed gravel, consisting of not ~~more~~ than three layers of crushed gravel.
- 4th, by rolling the street if deemed necessary.

The said draining and grading to be done and paid for by the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and the graveling to be done and paid for by the owners of the abutting real property and property specially benefitted thereby. The said work to be done as provided by the charter and ordinances of the said City and the laws of the State of Oregon. And

WHEREAS, The said Improvement has been fully completed to the satisfaction of the street superintendent and the City engineer of the said city and the report of the said street superintendent and city engineer has been filed with the recorder of the said city showing the total cost of the said improvement, and the cost of the said graveling, and that the said work has been done and completed to the satisfaction of the committee on streets and public property of the council of the said city, and that the said report shows the amount that should be charged and assessed to the several tracts and parcels of land abutting on the said street and specially benefitted thereby.
