

1 RESOLUTION NO. 13 FOR 1919

2  
3 Concerning the Vacation of a part of Fourth Street in J. M.  
4 Ralston's Fourth Addition, North of Oak Street.

5 WHEREAS, The Lebanon Canning Company, a Corporation has filed  
6 with the recorder of the City of Lebanon a petition asking for the  
7 vacation of the Following Part of Fourth Street in J. M. Ralston's  
8 Fourth Addition, to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to-wit:

9 "Beginning at the South East corner of Block 4 in J. M.  
10 Ralston's Fourth Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and run-  
11 ning thence East 60 feet; thence North 245 feet, thence  
12 Westerly to the North East corner of said Block 4 in said  
13 Addition, thence South to the place of beginning"

14 Which said petition is duly verified by the said petitioner. And  
15 WHEREAS, The said petitioner owns the following described lots and  
16 land abutting on the said street, to-wit:

17 All of Block 4 in J. M. Ralston's Fourth Addition to Lebanon, Ore-  
18 gon, as the same appears and is designated upon the map and plat of  
19 said Addition now on file and of record in the office of the Record-  
20 er of and for Linn County, Oregon, Also

21 Beginning at a point which is 120 feet West of the South West corner  
22 Block Ten in the Original Town of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon,  
23 as the same appears and is designated on the map and plat thereof, now  
24 on file and of record in the office of the recorder of and for Linn  
25 County, Oregon, and running thence North 245 feet, thence West 180  
26 feet, thence South 245 feet, thence East 180 feet to the place of be-  
27 ginning. And

28 WHEREAS, It appearing to the Council from the said petition and  
29 investigation that the said Lebanon Canning Company owns all the  
30 real property abutting on the said portion of the said street asked  
31 to be vacated, and it further appearing to the Council after due  
32 investigation and consideration that it will be for the best inter-  
est of all concerned and the said city and its inhabitants that the  
said portion of the said street be vacated and the petition granted.

33 ~~And~~ NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL,

34 That September 16th, 1919 at the council chambers in the City of  
35 Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. of  
36 said day be and the same is hereby fixed and set as the time and  
37 place for hearing any and all objections to the said petition or the  
38 vacation of the said portion of the said street.

1 And be it Further resolved, by the Council, that all persons  
2 having any objection to the said petition or the vacation of the  
3 said portion of the said Street file with the recorder of the said  
4 city the same on or before said time, and appear at same time and  
5 place and present any that they may have. And

6 Be It Further resolved, that the recorder of the said City be and  
7 he is hereby directed to give due and legal notice of the time and  
8 place of the hearing of the said petition to all persons concerned by  
9 posting four notices thereof in four of the most public and con-  
10 spicuous places in the said city, and where such notices are usually  
11 posted, give the time and place and purpose of the said hearing,  
12 and if no objections are made or offered or filed against the same  
13 that the same will be taken as confessed and that the said petition  
14 will be granted as prayed for.

15 Passed by the Council this 2nd day of September, 1919, ~~sixteen~~  
16 on the roll call of the council and the vote taken by aye and nay vote  
17 and entered in the journal of the council, a majority of all members  
18 elected to the council voting in favor of the passage of the resolu-  
19 tion.
