

1 RESOLUTION No. 15, FOR 1919.

2 RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE IMPROVE-  
3 MENT OF PARK AND ASH STREETS, IN LEBANON, OREGON.

4 WHEREAS, On the 16th day of September the common council of the  
5 City of Lebanon, Oregon, by resolution No. 14 for 1919 required of the  
6 city engineer of the said city, plans and specifications, and estimates  
7 of the probably total cost for the improvement of parts of Park Street  
8 and part of Ash Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, as follows-  
9 Park Street from the North <sup>Curb</sup> line of Grant Street to the South curb line  
10 of Sherman street, and from the North curb line of Ash street to the  
11 south curb line of Vine street, and

12 Whereas, the said City Engineer has filed with the recorder of the  
13 said city his plans and specifications and estimates of the probable  
14 total cost of the said improvement, and

15 WHEREAS, The said Council after due investigation and consideration of  
16 the same finds and determines that the said plans and specifications  
17 correct and the estimated cost and expenses of the said improvement  
18 to be reasonable, and the kinds of improvements proposed for the said  
19 streets are proper and the best for the same,

20 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL,

21 that the said plans, specification and estimated total probable  
22 cost and expenses of making the said improvements to the said streets  
23 be and the same is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed in all  
24 things.



