IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF WEST SHERMAN STREET
RESOLUTION NO. 6 FOR 1920, REQUIRING PLANS AND SPECIFICATION

2 WHEREAS, The common council deems it expedient and for the best in-
3 terest of the City of Lebanon to Improve certain streets in the said
4 city with crushed gravel, and the grade the same to proper subgrade
5 NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Common Council, of the City
6 of Lebanon, Oregon, that the said city requires of the city engin-
7 eer of the said city plans and specifications and estimates of the
8 total probable cost for the improvement of the following streets in
9 the following manner.

10 SHERMAN STREET FROM 5 STREET TO WEST LINE OF 7th Street in Lebanon
11 Oregon, as follows:-

- 12 1st, By grading the roadway of said street to proper subgrade
- 13 2nd, by graveling the road way of the said street to a width of not
14 more than 12 feet with at least two layers of crushed gravel
and for about 6 inches thick
- 15 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said street.

16 That the grading of the said street be done and paid for by the city
17 of Lebanon, Oregon.

18 That the graveling and other costs of the said improvement be done
19 by the city of Lebanon, and the costs and expense thereof be paid
20 by the owners of the real property abutting upon the said street
21 to be improved and the real property specially benefitted thereby,
22 and that the said cost and expense be made a charge against the
23 said real property.

24 That the said plans and specification be filed with the recorder
25 of the city of Lebanon on or before the 18th day of May, 1920.
