

1 IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAPLE AND PARK STREETS
2 IN LEBANON, OREGON.

3 RESOLUTION NO. 9 FOR 1920.

4 WHEREAS, on the 20th day of April, 1920, there was filed with
5 the recorder of the city of Lebanon, a petition signed by more
6 than a majority of all the owners of the real property abutting
7 upon and specially benefitted by the improvement of Maple street
8 and Park Street as herein after mentioned, and more the owners
9 of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the
10 said improvement of specially benefitted thereby, and

11 WHEREAS, of the said 20th day of April, 1920 the council duly
12 passed and adopted resolution No. 2 requiring of the city
13 engineer plans, specification and estimates of the total proba-
14 ble cost of the said improvement and

15 WHEREAS, on the said 20th day of April, 1920, the city engineer
16 duly filed with the recorder of the said city his plans and
17 specification for the said improvement with an estimate of the
18 total probable cost of the same, which said plans, specifications
19 was by the council duly approved and conformed, and the council
20 thereupon duly passed and enacted a resolution wherein it deemed
21 it expedient to make the said improvement. and

22 WHEREAS, the work has been fully done and completed and the
23 said city engineer and superintendent of streets have filed their
24 report in writing of the completion of the said work to the
25 satisfaction of the said city, and the council has by resolution
26 duly ratified and approved the same, and

27 WHEREAS, on the 6th day of July, 1920, the said Superintendent
28 of streets and City Engineer filed with the recorder of the said
29 city an assessment roll of the said improvement wherein there
30 is assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of land
31 its just and proportionate share of the said cost and expense of
32 making the said improvement, and

1 WHEREAS, the council has by Resolution duly approved the said
2 assessment roll by resolution duly enacted and passed by the
3 Council the 6th day of July, 1920,

4 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
5 LEBANON, OREGON,

6 That there is hereby levied against each separate and individual
7 lot and tract of land abutting on the said improvement, the said
8 sums and amount as set out in the said assessment roll which
9 said assessment roll is hereto attached and made a part of this
10 resolution, and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED,

12 That the recorder of the city of Lebanon, is hereby authorized
13 empowered and directed to enter upon the docket of city liens
14 as provided by the charter of the said city the said several
15 sum and amounts against the said several lots, and tracts and
16 individuals therein named, and he is further notified to
17 and directed to proceed to collect the said several sums
18 as providing by the charter of the said city, and he is hereby
19 directed and empowered to do all other things necessary and
20 required of him by the said city and ordinances of the said
21 city in relation to the said assessment and the collecting of
22 the same.

23 This Resolution was duly enacted and passed by the Council
24 this 6th day of July, 1920 by aye and nay vote of the roll call
25 of the council and the vote entered in the journal of the council
26 all members elected to the council voting in favor of the reso-
27 lution.
