IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF 5th STREET FROM OAK STREET
TO NORTH LINE OF LOT 8 IN BLOCK 5 IN SMITH'S FIRST ADD. AND
Sherman street from 4th Street to Seventh Street.

Resolution No. 11 for 1920.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of May 1920, 1920, there was filed with
the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, a petition signed by ^{the owners of} more
that a majority of all the real property abutting on the hereinaf-
ter mentioned and described streets, asking that the city cause
the said streets to be improved as follows;-

5th Street from Oak Street North to the North line of Lot 8 in
Smith First Addition, and Sherman Street from ~~4th~~ street west to
Seventh Street, the same to be improved as follows:

- 1st, By Grading the Streets to proper sub grade.
- 2nd, by graveling the road way of the said streets with crushed
gravel for a width of 12 feet
- 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

WHEREAS, on the said 4th day of May, 1920, the common Council of
the City of Lebanon duly passed an ^{Resolution} ordinance requiring of the
City engineer plans, specifications and the estimates of the
total probable cost of the said improvement as asked for in the
said petition.

Whereas, On the said 4th day of May, 1920 the said City engineer
filed with the recorder of the said City his plans, and specifica-
tions for the improvement of the said streets together with his
estimate of the total probable ~~costs~~ of the same, which said plans
and specification and estimates was by the council, of the said
city on the said 4th day of May, 1920 duly approved by resolution
of the said council duly passed and enacted by the said council.
and

WHEREAS, on the said 4th day of May, 1920 the said Council duly
passed and enacted a resolution wherein the said council deemed it
expedient and for the best interest of the said city to make the
said improvements as prayed for in the said petition and as set
out in the said plans and specifications on the said city engineer r.

And

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of August 1920 the said city engineer and

1 City Street Superintendent filed with the recorder of the said
2 city their report in writing showing that the said improvement had
3 been completed according to the said petition, the plans and speci-
4 fications therefor, and that the cost of the said has not exceeded
5 the estimates of the total probable cost of the same as made and
6 filed with the recorder by the city engineer, and
7 WHEREAS, on the said 3rd day of August 1920, the said City Engineer
8 and Street Superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city
9 their assessment roll of the said improvement showing the amount
10 assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of the land
11 abutting upon the said improvement and the real property specially
12 benefitted thereby, which said assessment roll was on the said 3rd
13 day of ^{August} December 1920 duly accepted, ratified and approved by the
14 common council of the said city,

15 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON.
16 That there is hereby levied against each separate lot and tract of
17 land abutting upon the said improvement the said sums and amounts
18 as set out in the said assessment roll which said assessment roll
19 is hereto attached and made a part of this resolution. and
20

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL

22 That the recorder of the City of Lebanon be and he is hereby di-
23 rected, authorized and empowered to enter upon the docket of city
24 liens the said several sums and amounts against the said several lots
25 and tracts and parcels of land as described and set out in the said
26 assessment roll, as liens against the said lots and tracts and par-
27 cels of land, and he is hereby further directed, empowered and au-
28 thorized to collect the said several sums from the owners or reputed
29 owners of the said several lots and tracts of land as provided by
30 the charter and ordinances of the said city and the laws of the
31 state of Oregon. And he is hereby directed, empowered and authorized
32 to any and all other things necessary and required by ~~the~~ the said

1 charter and laws of him to be done in relation to the said assess-
2 ment and collecting the said amounts of same.

3 This resolution was duly enacted by the Council on this 3rd day
4 of August 1920, by aye and nay vote on the roll call of the
5 council and the note entered in the journal of the council pro-
6 ceedings, all members elected to the council voting in favor of
7 the resolution.
