

RESOLUTION NO. 127 FOR 1920

IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF THIRD STREET FROM TENGANT STREET TO MARY STREET IN LEBANON, OREGON.

1 Resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, in Linn
2 County, State of Oregon, that,

3 WHEREAS, there is on file with the recorder of the said City a
4 petition asking for the improvement of Third Street from the North
5 Line of Tangent Street North to Mary Street in the said City, in
6 the following manner.

- 7
8 1st.- By Grading the said Street to proper subgrade.
9 2nd.- BY Graveling the roadway of the said street for a wothth of
10 12 feet with crushed river gravel or shreened gravel to
11 a proper thickness.
12 3rd.- By making proper drainage for the said street.

13 And Be It Further resolved that the council finds and ascer-
14 tains from the said petition, and from the report of the City en-
15 gineer and from investigation that the said petition is duly
16 signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real proper-
17 ty.abutting upon the said street and the real property specially
18 benefitted by the said improvement. And that the said petition
19 asks that the said improvement be made by the said city and
20 that no notice of the intention of the said city to make the same
21 be given or any other notice concerning the same be given and
22 that no bids be asked for or received fro the making of the said
23 , and the said petitioners specially waive any and all further
24 notices in the said matter of the said improvement.

25 And Be It Further resolved by the Council that by reason of the
26 said petition and as provided by Article IV of the charter of the
27 said City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the city has acquired jurisdic-
28 tion to make the said improvement asprayed for in the said petition.

29 And Be It Further resolved that the said City of Lebanon, Deems
30 it expedient and for the best interest of the said city to make
31 the said improvement to the said street as prayed for, and that
32 the city ptoceed to make the same as prayed for without any further
33 notice or the advertising for bids for same, and that the city do
34 the said work under the direction of the city engineer and the

1 superintendent of streets of the said city and the committee on
2 streets and public property of the said city. And that the cost
3 of the grading be paid by the city of Lebanon, out of any funds
4 available for that purpose, and that the cost of the graveling
5 and drainage and other costs thereof be paid by the owners of the
6 abutting real property and real property specially benefitted
7 thereby, and that the said costs be made a lien against the said
8 abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted
9 by the said improvement. And be it further resolved, that the plans
10 specifications and estimates for said improvement are hereby approved.
11 Passed by the Council this 16th day of November 1920 on the roll
12 call of the council and that the member of the council voting in f
13 favor of the said resolution and the vote being entered in the
14 journal of the council proceedings.
