

RESOLUTION NO. 14 FOR 1920.

1 INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN B. L. Cotton.

2 Resolution adopting a budget of expenditures for the fiscal  
3 year 1921, and making and fixing to amount of money to be  
4 raised to meet the said expenditures:

5 WHEREAS, It is necessary that money and funds be raised to  
6 meet the expenditures of the government of the City of Lebanon,  
7 in Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1921 and for the  
8 payment of the Salary of the City officers of the said City for  
9 the said year, and to pay the interest on the bonded indebted-  
10 ness of the said City, and to pay the maturing bonds of the said  
11 city, and for fire protection, lighting the streets of the said  
12 city, and for improvements of the streets, including the repair  
13 of streets, and crosswalks and bridges of the said city and for  
14 other purposes incidental to the city government of the said  
15 City for the said year, and

16 WHEREAS the Council of the said City has adopted a budget sys-  
17 tem for the said city as by law required.

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
19 OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IN LINN COUNTY, OREGON,

20 That the following be and the same is hereby adopted as the  
21 budget of expenditures for the City of Lebanon, in Linn County  
22 Oregon, for the fiscal year of 1921, and that the several sums  
23 therein named shall be and are hereby appropriated for the sev-  
24 eral purposes and objects therein named and specified, as follows:-

And Be It Further Resolved, that no office or head of any department of the City government shall during the said fiscal year 1921, incur or create any debt, liability or obligation on behalf of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, against any of the said accounts which in the aggregate shall exceed the amounts herein appropriated for his department or office, unless the Council shall first specially authorize such additional expenditure or liability or obligation, and shall have provided for the payment therefor, And

WHEREAS, In order to meet the said sums as herein appropriated and to pay the said sums, it is necessary to raise money by direct taxation on all the taxable property in the said city

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER Resolved that there be and is hereby levied against all the taxable property of the and within the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, as shown by the assessment roll for the year 1920 in the office of the Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, a tax sufficient to raise the said sums as herein before enumerated and specified, in the said sum of \$20,411.00 less the sum of Of. \$907. raised by licenses, fines and other sources in the said city, and that the said sums to be raised by taxation be and is the sum of \$19,504.00, and also less the sum raised by the road levy made by Linn County, Oregon, for road purposes.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the recorder of the City of Lebanon, at Once notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, in writing of the amount of money hereby required to be raised by taxation by the said city for the said year 1921.
