

IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF FIFTH STREET AND SHERMAN
STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.
RESOLUTION REQUIRING PLANS AND SPECIFICATION FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT

RESOLUTION NO. 4 FOR 1920.

2 WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County,
3 Oregon, deems it expedient and for the best interest of the City of
4 Lebanon, Oregon, and its inhabitants to improve certain streets of
5 the said City, by grading the same to proper sub-grade, and by grav-
6 eling the roadway of the said streets with crushed gravel, and
7 WHEREAS, the owners of more than a majority of the abutting real
8 property on the said streets and the real property specially ben-
9 efitting by the said improvements have filed with the recorder of
10 the said city a petition asking for the improvements of the here-
11 inafter described and mentioned streets.

12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the said City, that
13 the council requires of the City engineer of the said city plans,
14 specification and estimates of the total probable cost of the said
15 improvement as asked for in the said petition, as follows:-

16 FIFTH STREET from Oak street North to North line of Lot 8 in Smith's
17 First Addition to Lebanon, if extended west.

18 SHERMAN STREET from the west line of Third Street to the West line
19 of Fifth Street, the said improvement to consist of the following:-

- 20 1st, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper sub-grade
21 2nd By Graveling the roadway of the said streets with Crushed gravel
not to exceed 12 feet in width and six inches thick.
22 3rd, By Making proper drainage for the said streets.

23 That the grading be done and paid for by the City of Lebanon.

24 That the graveling be done by the said City and the cost and ex-
25 pense thereof be paid by the owners of the abutting real property
26 and the real property specially benefitted by the said improvement.
27 and that the draining be paid for the by said owners of the abutting
28 real property and real property specially benefitted thereby. and
29 that the said cost and expenses be made a charge against the said
30 abutting real property and real property specially benefitted there by.

31 That the said plans and specifications and estimate of the total
32 probable costs thereof be filed with the recorder of the said City
on or before May 4th, 1920.
