

IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF FIFTH STREET AND SHERMAN
STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.

RESOLUTION NO. 5 FOR 1920

1 WHEREAS on the 4th day of May, 1920, there was filed with the
2 recorder a petition asking for the improvement of certain streets
3 as hereinafter provided, and

4 WHEREAS, on the said 4th day of May, 1920 the Common Council of
5 the City of Lebanon, Oregon, passed a resolution no. 4 for 1920
6 requiring of the City engineer of the said City of Lebanon, plans
7 and specification and the estimates of the probable total costs
8 for the said improvement of the said hereinafter mentioned and de-
9 scribed streets, and

10 WHEREAS, on the 4th day of May, 1920, the City engineer filed with
11 therecorder his report of his plans and the estimates of the
12 probable total costs of the improvement of the said streets, which
13 said streets are described as follows:

14 FIFTH STREETS from Oak Street North to the North line of Lot 8 in
15 Smith's First Addition if extended west, and

16 SHERMAN STREET from the west line of THIRD Street west to the WEST
17 Line of FIFTH STREET, and that the said improvement be made as

18 follows:

- 19 1st, By Grading the said streets to proper sub-grade.
20 2nd, By graveling the roadway of the said streets not to exceed
21 12 feet in width with Crushed Gravel.
22 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

23 Now THEREFORE Be It Resolved by the Commons Council of the City of
24 Lebanon, Oregon, that the said plans, specifications and the esti-
25 mates of the probable total costs be and the same are in all things
26 approved, ratified and confirmed. And

27 Be It Further Resolved by the said Council, that the said council
28 finds and ascertains from the said report of the said Engineers
29 and investigation
30 and from the said petition and from examination/ that the petition
31 f iled with the recorder on the 4th day of May, 1920 asking for the
32 said improvement is duly signed by the owners of more than a majority
of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement
and the real property specially benefitted thereby, and the said
petition asks that the said improvements be made without any further

1 notice to the owners of the abutting real property or the real
2 roperty specially benefitted thereby, and without advertis-
3 ing for bids for the said improvement, and

4 Be It Further Resolved by the said Council that by reason of
5 the said petition and as provided by Article IV of the Charter
6 of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the said City has acquired
7 jurisdiction to make the said improvement as prayed for in the
8 said petition. And

9 Be It Further resolved, that the said City of Lebanon deems it
10 for the best interest and expedient to make the said improvement
11 to the said streets as prayed for, and that the said City pro-
12 ceed to make or cause to be made the said improvement to the said
13 streets as prayed for in the said petition, without any further
14 notice or the advertising of any bids for same, and that the City
15 do the said work, under the direction of the city engineer, Su-
16 perintendent of streets and Committee on Streets and Public prop-
17 erty of the said Council.

18 Passed by the Council this 4th day of May, on the roll call of
19 the council all members elected to the council voting in favor
20 of the resolution.
