RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SHERMAN STREET FROM 1 PARK STREET EAST TO HIATT STREET AND HIATT 2 STREET FROM SHERMAN STREET SOUTH TO GRANT STREET. ... WHEREAS, The Common Council of the city of Lebanon deem it expedient and for the best interest of the said city to improve 5 certain streets of the said city by grading the same to proper G subgrade, and by gradeing the roadway of the said streets with 7 crushed gravel, and 8 WHEREAS, there is a petition on file with the recorder of the said City praying for the improvement of the hereinafter men-10 tioned streets, 11 12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the common council of the 13 city of Lebanon, Oregon, requires of the City engineer and 14 street superintendent of the said City plans, specifications 15 and estimates of the total probable cost for the improvement 16 of the following streets, to_wit 17 Sherman Street from Park Street East to Hiatt Street, and Hiatt Street from Sherman Street 18 South to Grant Street. 19 The said improvement to be made in the following manner: 20 lst, By Grading the roadway of the said street to proper subgrade. 21 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said street for a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel and for proper 22 thickness to make good road. 3rd, by making proper drainage for the street. 23 That the grading of the said street and the spreading of the 24 gravel after the same is hauled on the street be done by and 25 at the expense of the city of Lebanon, and that the same be 26 for paid/out of the road or general or other funds of the said city. 27 That the cost of the graveling of the said street with crushed 28 gravel be done at the expense of the owners of the abutting real 29 property and the real property specially benefitted thereby and 80 that the same be made a lien and charge against such property. 31 That the said plans and specifications be filed with the recorder
