RESOLUTION NO. 7. FOR 1921. 1 2 WHEREAS, there was filed with the recorder of the city of Lebanon 3 Oregon, on the lat day of February, 1921, a petition praying for 4 the improvement of the hereinafter mentioned and described street 5 and it appearing to the council from the said petition that 6 the same is signed by the owners of more than a majority of all 7 the real property abutting on the said proposed improvement, and 8 after investigation by the council the council finds that the G said petition is signed by the owners of more than a majority 10 of all the real property abutting thereon, and real property 11 specially benefitted thereby, and 12 WHEREAS, The Council did on the 15th day of February, 1921, duly 13 adopt and pass a mesolution requiring of the City engineer 14 and street superintendent of the said city plans and specifica-15 tion and estimates of the probable total cost of the said im-16 provement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were 17 on the 15th day of February, 1921 filed with the recorder of 18 the said city. 19 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY 20 of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, that the council deems it 21 expedient and for the best interest of the said city to make 22 the siad improvement, the said improvements to be made on 23 the following streets and in the manner hereinafter described. 24 SHERMAN STREET from Park Street East to Hiatt Street. 25 HTATT STREET from Sherman Street South to Grant Street. 26 That the said improvement be made in the following manner, 27 lst, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper subgrade 28 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said streets for a width of twelve feet with crushed gravel and for a thickness 29 of about 6 inches. 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets. 30 That the said improvement be made and done in accordance 31

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    city of Lebanon, Oregon, out of any funds available therefor,
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    and that the cost of the graveling and other costs of the said
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    improvement be paid by the owners of the real property abutting

      That the City Engineer and superintendent of Streets of the said
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    City have filed with the recorder of the said City their plans,
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    specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost of

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    to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the
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    real property specially benefitted thereby in the sum of $237.69,

      That the said plans, specifications and estimates of the said
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    City engineer and street superintendent are hereby in all things
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    ratified and approved and affirmed.
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      That it is hereby further resolved, that there is on file

   herein in this matter a petition duly signed by the owners of
   more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the
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    said proposed improvement, asking that the same by made without
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    any further notice or the calling for bids for the same or the
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    giving any further notice of the intention of making same or the
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   making of the same and they specially waive any and all further
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with the provision of Article IV of Chapter VIII of the

Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions of the said Charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the
