1 RESOLUTION NO. 7. FOR 1921.

2 WHEREAS, there was filed with the recorder of the city of Lebanon  
3 Oregon, on the 1st day of February, 1921, a petition praying for  
4 the improvement of the hereinafter mentioned and described street  
5 and it appearing to the council from the said petition that  
6 the same is signed by the owners of more than a majority of all  
7 the real property abutting on the said proposed improvement, and  
8 after investigation by the council the council finds that the  
9 said petition is signed by the owners of more than a majority  
10 of all the real property abutting thereon, and real property  
11 specially benefitted thereby, and

12 WHEREAS, The Council did on the 15th day of February, 1921, duly  
13 adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the City engineer  
14 and street superintendent of the said city plans and specifica-  
15 tion and estimates of the probable total cost of the said im-  
16 provement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were  
17 on the 15th day of February, 1921 filed with the recorder of  
18 the said city,

19 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
20 of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, that the council deems it  
21 expedient and for the best interest of the said city to make  
22 the said improvement, the said improvements to be made on  
23 the following streets and in the manner hereinafter described.

24 SHERMAN STREET from Park Street East to Hiatt Street.

25 HIATT STREET from Sherman Street South to Grant Street.

26 That the said improvement be made in the following manner,

- 27  
28 1st, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper subgrade  
29 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said streets for a width  
30 of twelve feet with crushed gravel and for a thickness  
of about 6 inches.  
31 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

32 That the said improvement be made and done in accordance

1 with the provision of Article IV of Chapter VIII of the  
2 Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions  
3 of the said Charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the  
4 State of Oregon, known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act" and in  
5 accordance with the petition filed asking for the said improve-  
6 ment, and in accordance with the plans and specifications of the  
7 city engineer filed with the recorder on the 15th day of February  
8 1921, and endorsed, "Plans for the Improvement of SHERMAN-HIATT  
9 STREETS"

10 That the cost of the grading the said street be paid by the  
11 city of Lebanon, Oregon, out of any funds available therefor,  
12 and that the cost of the graveling and other costs of the said  
13 improvement be paid by the owners of the real property abutting  
14 on the said improvement and the real property specially benefitted  
15 thereby,

16 That the City Engineer and superintendent of Streets of the said  
17 City have filed with the recorder of the said City their plans,  
18 specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost of  
19 the said improvement, in the sum of <sup>\$600.00</sup>~~\$287.00~~, and the sum thereof  
20 to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the  
21 real property specially benefitted thereby in the sum of <sup>\$17.00</sup>~~\$237.00~~,

22 That the said plans, specifications and estimates of the said  
23 City engineer and street superintendent are hereby in all things  
24 ratified and approved and affirmed.

25 That it is hereby further resolved, that there is on file  
26 herein in this matter a petition duly signed by the owners of  
27 more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the  
28 said proposed improvement, asking that the same be made without  
29 any further notice or the calling for bids for the same or the  
30 giving any further notice of the intention of making same or the  
31 making of the same and they specially waive any and all further  
32 notice in the matter.

1 It therefor further resolved that the city has acquired  
2 jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with  
3 the said petition and the said plans, and specifications. And  
4 Be It Further resolved that the City Engineer and Street Super-  
5 intendent proceed to make the said improvements to be said  
6 streets, in accordance with the said petitions and said plans  
7 and specifications therefor, and report to the Council when  
8 the said work is completed and finished,

9 Passed by the Council the 15th day of February, 1921.

10 Approved by the Mayor this 15th day of February, 1921.
