city of Lebanon, or caused to be done by said city and the cost thereof and the other costs and expenses of the said improvement be paid for by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby, and that the said cost and expenses of same be made a lien and charge against the said abutting real property and the real property specially bene-
