South to the city õ linits and for the improvement of E street from Second Street 6 East to Main Street, and 7 WHEREAS, It appears to the council from examination and from 8 the report of the city engineer and street superintendent that 9 the said petition is duly signed by the owners of more than a 10 majority of all the real property abutting upon the said improve-11 or st cets proposed to be improved, and ky the real propment 12 erty specially benefitted thereby, and 13 WHEREAS, The common council did on the 15th day of February, duly 14 adopt a resolution requirung of the city engineer and street 15 superintendent of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, plans, specifications 16and estimates of the probable total costs of making the said improve. 17ment as prayed for in said petition, which said plans and specifi-18cations and estimates were by the said city engineer and street 19 superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city on the 20 15th day of February, 1921. 21 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON. 22that the council deems it expedient and for the best inter-Oregon, 23est of the said city to make the said improvements as prayed for 24 in said petition as follows: 25SECOND STREET 26From Oak Street South to City Limits, and E STREET from Second 27Street East to Main Street. and 28That the said improvements be hade as follows: 29 lst By grading the roadway of said streets to proper subgrade: 30 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said streets is proper set xgrade for a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel and to 31 thickness of about six inches.

3rd, By making proper surface drainage for the streets.

That the making of the said improvements be done in accordance 1 $\mathbf{2}$ with the provisions of Article IV or Chapter VIII of the Charter 3 of the Cityof Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions of said 4 charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the State of Oregon 5 known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act" and in accordance with the 6 petition filed asking for the said improvements, and in accordance 7 with the plans and specifications of the city engineer and street 8 superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city on the 9 15th day of Febtuary, 1921 marked and endorsed "PLANS FOR IMPROVE_ 10 MENT OF SECOND ANDE STREETS"

That the City engineer and superintendent of streets have filed with the recorder their estimates of the probable total cost of 1249,23maing the said improvement in the sum of 5685,00, and that the 130,a0sum thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon is the sum of 53,00and the sum ther of to be paid by the owners of abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby is 1089,23the sum of 577,00.

That the said plans, and specifucations and the said estimates ere hereby in all things approved, rstified and affirmed.

And Be It Further pesolved, that there is on file with the recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a petition duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the said pr posed improvement and of all the real property specially benefitted by the said proposed improvements asking and praying that the said improvements be made and done
