

RESOLUTION NO. 9, FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SECOND STREET FROM OAK STREET SOUTH TO CITY LIMITS AND FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF E STREET FROM SECOND STREET EAST TO MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, there was filed with the recorder of the City of Lebanon Oregon, on February, 15th, 1921 a petition praying for the improvement of Second Street from Oak street South to the city limits and for the improvement of E street from Second Street east to Main Street, and

WHEREAS, It appears to the council from examination and from the report of the city engineer and street superintendent that the said petition is duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon the said improvement or streets proposed to be improved, and by the real property specially benefitted thereby, and

WHEREAS, The common council did on the 15th day of February, duly adopt a resolution requiring of the city engineer and street superintendent of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, plans, specifications and estimates of the probable total costs of making the said improvement as prayed for in said petition, which said plans and specifications and estimates were by the said city engineer and street superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city on the 15th day of February, 1921,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, Oregon, that the council deems it expedient and for the best interest of the said city to make the said improvements as prayed for in said petition as follows:

SECOND STREET

From Oak Street South to City Limits, and E STREET from Second Street East to Main Street. and

That the said improvements be made as follows:

- 1st By grading the roadway of said streets to proper subgrade:
- 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said streets ~~to a width of 12 feet~~ for a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel and to thickness of about six inches.
- 3rd, By making proper surface drainage for the streets.

1 That the making of the said improvements be done in accordance
2 with the provisions of Article IV or Chapter VIII of the Charter
3 of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions of said
4 charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the State of Oregon
5 known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act" and in accordance with the
6 petition filed asking for the said improvements, and in accordance
7 with the plans and specifications of the city engineer and street
8 superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city on the
9 15th day of Febtuary, 1921 marked and endorsed "PLANS FOR IMPROVE-
10 MENT OF SECOND ANDE STREETS"

11 That the cost of the grading the said streets be paid by the
12 city of Lebanon, Oregon, out of any funds available for that
13 purpose, and the cost of the drainage of same be paid by the
14 city of Lebanon, and the cost of the graveling and other costs
15 and expenses of making the said improvements be paid by the
16 owners of the abutting real property and the real property spec-
17 ially benefitted thereby, .

18 That the City engineer and superintendent of streets have filed
19 with the recorder their estimates of the probable total cost of
20 maing the said improvement in the sum of ^{1249.23}~~522.00~~, and that the
21 sum thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon is the sum of ^{150.00}~~83.00~~
22 and the sum ther of to be paid by the owners of abutting real
23 property and the real property specially benefitted thereby is
24 the sum of ^{1089.23}~~575.00~~.

25 That the said plans, and specifucations and the said esti-
26 mates ere hereby in all things approved, retified and affirmed.

27 And Be It Further resolved, that thereis on file with the
28 recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a petition duly signed
29 by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property
30 abutting on the said pr posed improvement and of all the real
31 property specially benefitted by the said proposed improvements
32 asking and praying that the said improvements be made and done

1 without advertising for or calling for bids for same, and without
2 giving any further notice of the intention to make the same or any
3 other notices in connection therewith, and the said petitioners
4 specially waive any and all other and further notice in the matter,
5 And Be It Further Resolved that by reason thereof the City has
6 acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvements as prayed for
7 in the said petition and according to the said plans and specifica-
8 tions and according to the provisions of the charter of the said
9 city of Lebanon. And

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the city engineer and the street
11 superintendent of the said city make and file with the recorder
12 of the city of Lebanon a report in writing when the said im-
13 provements are completed and that they at once proceed to make
14 the same as provided herein.
