RESOLUTION NO. 11 FOR 1921.

1 RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ELMORE, FRANKLIN, HIATT,
2 WILLIAMS AND GROVE STREETS IN LEBANON, OREGON.

3 WHEREAS, The Common Council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon,
4 deems it expedient to improve certain streets inthe City
5 of Lebanon, Oregon, and

6 WHEREAS, these is on file with the recorder of the said Cit y
7 of Lebanon, a petition praying for the improvement of the here-
8 inafter mentioned streets, and it appearing to the Councilffrom
9 the said petition that the same is duly signed by the owners
10 of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on
11 the said streets to be im roved and ~~byxmme~~ the real property
12 specially benefitted thereby, and after due investigation the
13 council finds that the said petition is duly signed by the
14 owners of more than a majority of all the real property abut-
15 ting on the said proposed improveant and the real property
16 specially benefitted thereby, And

17 WHERAS? The Council did on the 15th day of March 1921 duly
18 adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the city engineer
19 and the city superintendent of stteets plans and specifica-
20 tions and the estimates of the probable total cost of the
21 said improvements, which said plans, and specification and
22 estimates were on the 15th day of March, 1921 duly filed
23 with the recorder of the said city.

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the
25 city of Lebanon, Oregon, that the council deems it expedient
26 and for the best interest of the city of Lebanon to improve
27 the following streets and in the following manner.

28 ELMORE STREET from Main Street east to Franklin Street, and
29 Franklin Street from Elmore Street South to Milton Street, and
30 HIATT STREET, from Elmore Street North to Grant Street, and
31 WILLIAMS STREET from Edmore street North to Maple Street, and
32 GROVE STREET FROM Elmore Street North to Oak Street.

1 That the said improvements be made in the follow manner.

2 1st, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper sub-
3 grade.

4 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said street with crushed
5 gravel for a width of 12 feet and to a thickness of 6 in-
6 ches, with at least two layers or courses of grave l.

7 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

8 That the said improvement be made and done in accordance
9 with the provisions of Article IV of Chapter VIII of the
10 Charter of the City of Lebanon, and such other provisions
11 of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the
12 State of Oregon, known as the "Bankoft Bonding Act" and in
13 accordance with the petition on file asking for the said
14 improvements and in accordance with the plans and specifica-
15 tions of the city engineer and City Street superintendent
16 filed with the recorder of the said city on the 15th day of
17 March, 1921 and Marked "Plans and Specification and estimates
18 for the Improvement of Elmore Street District"

19 That the cots of the grading and drainage of the said streets
20 be done by and paid by the city of Lebanon but of any funds
21 available for that purpose, and that the cost of the graveling
22 and the other costs of the said improvements
23 of the said streets be paid for by the owners of the abutting
24 real property and the real property specially benefitted there-
25 by.

26 That the City Engineer and Street Superintendent of the said
27 city have filled with the recorder of the said city their plans,
28 and specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost
29 of the said improvements in the sum of \$2449.66, and the sum
30 thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon, is the sum of \$500.00
31 and the sum thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting
32 real property and the real property specially benefitted there-
33 by is the sum of \$1949.66.

34 That the said plans and specifications and the estimates of
35 the probable total cost of the said improvement are hereby in

1 all things approved, ratified and affirmed.

2 And be it further resolved that there is on file with the
3 recorder of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, in this matter a
4 petition duly signed by the owners of more than a majority
5 of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed
6 improvement and the real property specially benefitted there-
7 by asking for the said improvement and that the same be made
8 without asking for any bids for same and that no bids be
9 received or had for same and that the city of Lebanon do or
10 cause the same to be done and made and that no further notice
11 be given of the intention to make the same or of the making
12 of the same, and they each and all jointly and severally waive
13 any and all further or additional notices in the matter.

14 It is therefore further resolved that by reason of the said
15 petition and the matters herein set out the city has acquired
16 jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with
17 the said petition, and the said plans and specifications and
18 the said estimates. And

19 Be it further resolved that the street Superintendent and
20 city engineer proceed to make the said improvements in ac-
21 cordance with the said petition and the charter of the said
22 city and the law governing the same, and that they make and
23 file a report in writing when the said work is completed
24 of the work done and the cost thereof to each lot and par-
25 cel of land.
