1 2	RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ELMORE, FRANKLIN, HIATT, WILLIAMS AND GROVE STREETS IN LEBANON, OREGON.
3	WHEREAS, The Common Council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon,
4	deems it expedient to improve certain streets inthe City
5	of Lebanon, Oregon, and
6	WHEREAS, these is on file with the recorder of the said Cit y
7	of Lebanon, a petition praying for the improvement of the here
8	inafter mentioned streets, and it appearing to the Councilfrom
9	the said petition that the same is duly signed by the owners
10	of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on
11	the said streets to be im roved and kxxmexe the real property
12	specially benefitted thereby, and after due investigation the
13	council finds that the said petition is duly signed by the
14	owners of more than a majority of all the real property abut-
15	ting on the said proposed improve ent and the real property
16	specially benefitted thereby, And
17	WHERAS? The Council did on the 15th day of March 1921 duly
18	adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the city engineer
19	and the city superintendent of streets plans and specifica-
20	tions and the estimates of the probable total cost of the
21	said improvements, which said plans, and specification and
22	estimates were on the 15th day nof March, 1921 duly filed
23	with the recorder of the said city.
2425	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the
26	city of Lebanon, Oregon, that the council deems it expedient
27	and for the best interest of the city of Lebanon to improve
28	the following streets and in the following manner.
29	ELMORE STREET from Main Street east to Franklin Street, and
30	Franklin Street from Elmore Street South to Milton Street, and
31	HIATT STREET, from Elmore Street North to Grant Street, and
32	WILLIAMS STREET from Edmore street North to Maple Street, and
)	GROVE STREET FROM Elmore Street North to Oak Street.

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That the said improvements be made in the follow manner. 1 2 1st, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper subgrade. 2nd, By Graveling the raodway of the said street with crushed gravel for a width of 12 feet and to a thickness of 6 inches, with at least two layers or coarses of grave 1. 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets. ħ That the said improvement be made and done in accordance with the provisions of Article IV of WhapterVIII of the 7 Charter of the City of Lebanon, and such other provisions 8 of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the "Banchoft Bonding Act" and in 10 accordance with the petition on file asking for the said 11 improvements and in accordance with the plans and specifica-12 tions of the city engineer and City Street superintendent 13 filed with the recorder of the said city on the 15th day of 14 March, 1921 and Narked "Plans and Specification and Estimates 15 for the Improvement of Elmore Street District" 16 That the cots of the grading and drainage of the said streets 17 be done by and paid by the city of Lebanon but of any funds . 18 19 available for that purpose, and that the cost of the graveling and the other costs of the said improvements 20 of the said streets be paid for by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted there-21 22 by. 23 That the City Engineer and Street Superintendent of the said 24 city have fil ed with the recorder of the said city their plans, 25 and specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost 26 of the said improvements in the sum of \$2449.66, and the sum 27 thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon, is the sum of \$500.00 28 and the sum thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted there-30 by is the sum of \$1949.66.

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That the said plans and epecifications and the estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvement are hereby in

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Recorder of the City of Lebanon/

And be it further resolved that there is on file with the recorder of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, in this matter a petition duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement and the real property specially benefitted thereby asking for the said improvement and that the same be made without asking for any bids for same and that no bids be received or had for same and that the city of Lebanon do or : cause the same to be done and made and that no further notice be goven of the intention tomake the same or of the making of the same, and they each and all jointly and severally waive any and all further or additional notices in the matter. It Is Therefore further resolved that by reason of the sai d petition and the matters herein set out the city has acquired

all things approved, ratified and affirmed.

jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition, and the said plans and specifications and the said estimates. And Be It Further resolved that the street Superintendent and

city engineer proceed to make the said improvements in accordance with the said petition and the sharter of the said city and the law governing the same, and that they make and file a report in writing when the said wrom in completed of the work done and the cost thereof to each lot and parcel of land.
