

RESOLUTION NO. 127 FOR 1921

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY THROUGH
BLOCK NO. 13 in Ralston's Addition to Lebanon
Oregon.

1 WHEREAS, There is on file with the recorder of the City of
2 Lebanon, Oregon, a petition duly signed by more than a majority
3 of all the abutting real property on the said alley asking that
4 the city cause the said alley to be graveled at the expense
5 of the abutting real property on the said alley.

6 Now Therefore the Common Council of the City of Lebanon
7 hereby requires of the city engineer and streets superintendent
8 of the said city plans and estimates of the total probable cost
9 of the said improvement of the said alley,, which said improve-
10 ment shall consist of graveling the said alley for a width of
11 8 feet with crushed gravel and for a thickness of about 5 inches
12 and that the said alley be graded so as to keep the water off
13 the road way of the alley.

15 That the entire cost of the said improvement be made ^{the expense and} at
16 paid for by the owners of the abutting real property.

17 That the said plans and estimates be filed with the recorder
18 of the said City on or before the 15th day of March, 1921.
