

RESOLUTION NO. 13 FOR 1921

1 RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY IN BLOCK NO. 13 IN
2 RALSTON'S ADDITION TO LEBANON, OREGON.

3 WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, deems
4 it advisable and expedient and for the best interest of the said
5 city to improve certain alleys in the said city, and

6 WHEREAS, There is on file with the recorder of the said city
7 a petition praying for the improvement of the alley in Block 13
8 in Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and it appearing to
9 the council that the said petition is duly signed by the owner
10 of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on
11 the said alley and the real property specially benefitted there-
12 by, and after examination and investigation the council ascertains
13 and determined that the said petition is so duly signed ^{the owners of} by more
14 than a majority of the real property abutting thereon and the
15 real property specially benefitted thereby, and

16 WHEREAS, The council did on the 15th day of March, 1921 duly
17 pass and adopt resolution No. 12 for 1922 requiring of the
18 city engineer and superintendent of streets of the city of
19 Lebanon, plans and estimates of the probable total cost of the
20 improvement of the said alley, which said plans and estimates
21 were duly filed with the recorder of the said city on the 15th
22 day of March, 1921..

23 NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, by the Council of the City of
24 Lebanon, Oregon, that the council hereby approved and ratified
25 and affirms the said plans and estimates, and be it further
26 resolved that the council deems it expedient to make the said
27 improvement as prayed for in the said petition, and that the
28 said improvement be made as follows.

29 By grading the alley to keep the water off the roadway
30 and by graveling the road way of the alley for a width of 8
31 feet with crushed gravel and for a thickness of five inches.

1 That the said improvement be made in accordance with the provisions
2 of Article IV of Charter VIII of the charter of the said of Lebanon
3 and such other provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and
4 the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act.
5 and in accordance with the said petition and the said plans and
6 estimates for the said improve ment.


7 That the entire cost of the said improvement be paid for by the
8 owners of the abutting real property and the realproperty specially
9 benefitted thereby. That the said City engneer and superintendent
10 hacc hive their plans am estimates of the said improvement and
11 the total estimate of the cost of the said improvement is the sum
12 of \$91.00 which sum is to be paid by the woners of the abutting
13 real property.

14 And BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by reason of the said petition
15 the city has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement in
16 accordance with the said petition of plans and estimates and the
17 said charter, and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that that the city engineer proceed to make
19 the said improvement in accordance with the said petition and the
20 said plans and estimates, and that when the work in completed that
21 the file with the recorder a report of the same, with the cost
22 thereof as assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of
23 land and of the work done and the amount of the cost thereof.
