RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY IN BLOCK NO. 13 IN 1 RALSTON'S ADDITION TO LEBANON, OREGON. 2 WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, deems З it advisable and expedient and for the best interest of the said Λ city to improve certain alleys in the said city, and 5 There is on file with the recorder of the said city WHEREAS, б a petition praying for the improvement of the alley in Block 13 7 in Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, and it appearing to 8 the council that the said petition is duly signed by the owner 9 of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on 10 the said alley and the real property specially benefitted there-11 by, and after examination and investigation the council ascertains 12the owners of and determined that the said petition is so duly signed/by/more 13 than a majority of the realproperty abutting thereon and the 14 real property specially benefitted thereby, and 15 WHEREAS, The council did on the 15th day of March, 1921 duly 16 paes and adopt resolution No. 12 for 1922 requiring of the. 17 city engineer and superintendent of streets of the city of 18 19 plans and estimates of the probable total cost of the Lebanon, improvement of the said alley, which said plans and estimates 20were duly filed with the recorder of the said city on the 15th 2122d y of March, 1921...

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, by the Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the council hereby approved and ratified and affirms the said plans and estimates, and be it further resolved that the council deems it expedient to make the said improvement as prayed for in the said petition, and that the said improvement be made as follows.

By grading the alley to keep the water off the raod-ay and by graveling the road way of the alley for a width of S fest with crushed greval and for a thickness of five inches.

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That the said improvement be made in accordance with the provisions of Article IV of Charter VIII of the charter of the said of Lebanon and such other provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act. and in accordance with the said petition and the said plans and estimates for the said improvement.

That the entire cost of the said improvement be paid for by the owners of the abutting real property and the realproperty specailly benefitted thereby. That the said City engeneer and superintendent hace hive their plans am estimates of the said improvement and the total estimate of the cost of the said improvement is the sum of \$91.00 which sum is to be paid by the woners of the abutting real property.

And BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by reason of the said petion the city has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition of plans and estimates and the said charter, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that that the city engineer proceed to make the said improvement inaccordance with the said petition and the said plans and estimates, and that when the work in completed that the file with the recorder a report of the same, with the cost thereof as assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of land and of the work done and the amount of the cost thereof.
