

RESOLUTION NO. & 16 FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION DECLARING A AS ASSESSMENT AND LIEN FOR THE IMPROVEMENT
CAROLINA AND PARK STREETS.

1
2 WHEREAS, on the 1st day of February 1921, there was filed with the
3 recorder of the City of Lebanon, a petition asking for the improvement
4 of Park Street from Isabella Street to Carolina Street and park Street
5 from Main Street to Park Street, which said petition was duly signed b
6 by the owner of more than a majority of all the real property abutting
7 of the said proposed improvement and the the real property specially
8 benefited thereby, and

9 WHEREAS, On the 1st day of February 1921, the common council of the
10 said city duly adopted and enacted a resolution requiring of the city
11 engineer and streetsuperintendent plans and specification and esti-
12 mates of the total probable cost of the said improvement of the
13 said streets; and

14 WHEREAS, on the said 1st day of February, 1921, the said city engineer
15 and street superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city
16 their plans and specifications and estimates of the probable total
17 cost of the said improvement of the said streets in accordance with
18 the said petition.

19 That the said estimates of the probable total cost of the said
20 improvement of the said streets as asked for was and is the sum of
21 \$287.60, and the part thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon
22 was the sum of \$50.00 and the part thereof to be paid by the owners
23 of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefit-
24 ted thereby was and is the sum of \$237.60.

25 WHEREAS, the said City engineer and superintendent of streets have
26 made and filed their report in writing with the recorder of the city
27 of Lebanon, Oregon, showing that the said improvement has been fully
28 and completely done and performed according to the said petition
29 asking for same and in accordance with the said plans and specifica-
30 tions and estimates, and that the total cost of making the said
31 improvement is the sum of \$261.00 and that the part thereof to be
32 paid by the city of Lebanon is \$45.00 and the amount thereof to be paid

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1 by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property speci-
2 ally benefitted thereby is the sum of \$216.00. And that all the said
3 sums are less than the estimates therefor. AND

4 WHEREAS, the said council did on the 1st day of February 1921 adopt
5 and enact a resolution approving the said plans and specifications and
6 estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvement and au-
7 thorized the work to be done without bids for the same as prayed
8 for in the said petition. and

9 WHEREAS, the report of the said city engineer and superintendent of
10 streets shows that in no case is any assessment larger or greater
11 than the estimate therefor.

12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the common council of the City of
13 Lebanon, Oregon, That the report of the City engineer and superintendent
14 of streets of the said improvement be and the same is hereby in all
15 things, ratified, approved and confirmed, and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the total cost of the said improvement
17 of the said streets is the sum of \$261.00 and that the portion there-
18 of to be paid by the city of Lebanon is the sum of \$45.00 and the sum
19 thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the
20 real property specially benefitted thereby, is the sum of \$216.00 And
21 be it further resolved That the amount assessed to and against the sep-
22 arate lots, tract and parcels of land be as follows:

And as soon as this resolution is passed and adopted by the Council and approved by the mayor, that he give due notice of the said lien and assessment to the owner or reputed owner of the said lots or land as herein specified. And BE IT FURTHER R SOLVED, that the said assessment roll as submitted and filed by the said city engineer and superintendent of streets be and the same is hereby inall things approved and ratified and affirmed. and the said assessment are hereby declared to be a lien against the said

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1 lots and parcels of land in the amounts threin specified.

2 This resolution adopted and enacted by the council on the 20th day
3 of May 1921 by the unanimous vote of the council taken by aye and
4 nay vote of the roll call and the vote entered in the journal of
5 the council proceedings.
