

1 RESOLUTION NO. 17 FOR 1921

2 WHEREAS, The common council deems it expedient and for the best in-
3 terest of the City of Lebanon to Improve certain streets of the said
4 city, by grading the same to proper subgrade and by graveling the
5 road way of such streets with crushed gravel. And

6 WHEREAS there is on file a petition praying for the improvement
7 of the herinafter mentioned and described street.

8 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council that the council
9 requires of the City engineer plans and specification and estimates
10 of the total probable cost of the improvement of the following
11 street.

12 WILLIAM STREET, From the North line of Vine Street to Isabella
13 Street, the said improvement to be as follows.

- 14 1st, By grading the road way of the said street to proper subgrade
15 2nd, By filling up the grade the low places in the said Street
16 3rd, By Graveling the road way of the said Street with crushed
gravel for a width of 12 feet and 6 inches thick.
4th, By making proper drainage for the said street.

17 That the grading be done by the city of Lebanon and paid for by
18 the said city out of any funds available for that purpose.

19 That the graveling and other expenses of the said improvement be
20 made at the expense of the abutting real property and real property
21 specially benefitted thereby, and that the said cost and expenses be
22 made a charge and lien against the said abutting real property and
23 the real property specially benefitted thereby.

24 That the said plans and specification be filed with the recorder
25 on or before May 20th, 1921.
