

RESOLUTION NO. 18 FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF WILLIAM STREET FROM VINE STREET  
TO ISABELLA STREET.

1  
2 WHEREAS, There is on file with the recorder of the city of Leba-  
3 non a petition duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of  
4 all the real property abutting upon the herein after described street  
5 asking for the improvement of the said street.

6 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
7 Lebanon, Oregon, that the Council deems it expedient to improve cer-  
8 tain streets of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and it appearing to the  
9 council and the council ascertains and determines that there is on  
10 file with the recorder a petition duly signed by the owners of more  
11 than a majority of all the real property abutting upon and specially  
12 benefitted by said proposed improvement, which said improvement is for  
13 the following Street.

14 WILLIAMS STREET, from Vine Street North of Isabella Street, and the  
15 said improvement to be made as follows:-

- 16 1st, By grading the roadway of the said street to proper subgrade:  
17 2nd, By filling up the low places in the said streets to grade.  
18 3rd, By graveling the roadway of the said street with crushed  
19 gravel for a width of 12 feet and to a thickness of 6  
20 inches.  
21 4th By making proper surface draining for the said street?

22 That the said improvement be made and done in accordance with  
23 Article IV of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, and such other  
24 provisions of the said Charter as relates thereto, and the ordinances  
25 of the said city, and of the laws of the State of Oregon known as the  
26 Bancroft Bonding Act." And in accordance with the said petition and  
27 the plans and specification and estimates of the City engineer, of  
28 the city of Lebanon, filed with the recorder on May 29th, 1921 and  
29 marked "Plans and Specification and Estimates for the Improvement of  
30 Williams Street"

31 That the cost of the grading of the said Street and the cost of  
32 making the drainage be paid by the city of Lebanon, and the costs  
of graveling the same and the other cost and expenses thereof by  
paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real

1 property and the real property specially benefitted thereby as  
2 provided by the charter and laws of the city of Lebanon and the State  
3 of Oregon..

4 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the said plans, specification  
5 and estimates be and the same are hereby in all things ratified and  
6 approved.

7 That it appears from the said estimates that the total cost  
8 of the said improvement to the said streets is the sum of \$271.26  
9 and that the cost thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon is \$60.00  
10 and the cost thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real  
11 property and the real property specially benefitted thereby is \$211.26

12 That it appears from the said petition on file asking for the said  
13 improvement that the said petitioners ask that the said improvement  
14 be made by the city of Lebanon and that no bids be asked for or re-  
15 ceived for same, and that no further notice be given of the making  
16 of the said improvement, and they specially waive any and all further  
17 notice in the matter. That by reason of the said petition for the  
18 said improvement, and the said estimates that the said city of  
19 Lebanon has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement in  
20 accordance with the said petition and the plans, specifications  
21 and estimates of the said City engineer. and that no further notice  
22 be given or had, and that no bids be advertised for or had for the  
23 making of the same. and that the said City engineer and Street super-  
24 intendent proceed to make or cause to be made the said improvement  
25 as herein provided.

26 Passed by the Council this 20th day of May, 1921, by unanimous vote  
27 of all members elected to the Council taken by aye and nay vote  
28 on roll call and entered in journal of council proceeding.

29 Approved by the Mayor May 20, 1921.
