RESOLUTION FOR OMPROVEMENT OF WILLIAM STREET FROMVINE STREET
TO ISABELLA STREET

TO ISABELLA STREET 1 There is on file with the recorder of the city of Leba... WHEREAS, non a petition duly signed by the owners of more thana majority of all the real property abutting upon the herein after described street asking for the improvement of the said street. 5 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Lebanon, Oregon, that the Council deems it expedient to improve cer-7 tain streets of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and it appearing to the × council and the council ascertains and determines that there is on 9 file with the recorder a petition duly signed by the owners of more 10 than a majority of all the real property abutting upon and specially 11 benefitted by said proposed improvement, which said improvement is for 12 the following Street. 13 WILLIAMS STREET, from Vine Street North of Isabella Street oand the 14 said improvement to be made as follows:\_ 15 1st, By grading the roadway of the said street to proper subgrade: 16 2nd, By filling up the low places in the said streets to grade. 3rd, By graveling the raodway of the said street with cruched gravel for a width of 12 feet and bo a thickness of 6 17 inches. 18 4th By making proper surface draining for the said street? 19 That the said improvement be made and done in accordance with 20 Article IV of the Charter of the Cirt of Lebanon, and such other 21

Article IV of the Charter of the Cirt of Lebanon, and such other provisions of the said Charter as relates theseto, and the ordinances of the said city, and of the laws of the State of Oregon known as the Bancroft Banding Act." And in assordance with the said petition and the plans and specification and estimates of the City engineer, of the city of Lebanon, filed with the pecorder on may 29th, 1921 and marked "Pland and Sepcification and estimates for the Improvement of Williams Street"

That the cost of the grading of the said Street and the cost of making the drainage be paid by the city of Lebanon, and the costs of graveling the same and the other cost and expenses thereof by paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real

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property and the real property specially benefitted thereby as provided by the charter and laws of the city of Lebanon and the State of Creton.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVER, That the said plans, specification and estimates be and the same are hereby in all things ratified and approved.

That it appears from the said estimates that the total of the said improvement to the said streets is the sum of \$271.26 and that the cost thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon is \$60.00 and the cost thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby is \$211.26 That is appears from the said petition on file asking for the said improvement that the said petitioners ask that the said improvement be made by the city of Lebanon and that no bids be asked for or received for same, and that no further notice be given of the making of the said improvement, and they specailly waive any and all further notice in the matter. That by reason of the said petition 66r the said improvement, and the said estimates that the said city of Lebanon has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition and the plans, specifications and estimates of the said City angineer, and that no further notice be given or had, and that no bids be advertised for or had for the making of the same. and that the said City engineer and Street superintendent proceed to make or coause to be made the said improvement as herein provided.

Passed by the Council this 20th day of May, 1921, by unanimous vote of all members elected to the Council taken by aye and may vote on roll call and entered in journal of council proceeding.
