

RESOLUTION NO. 20, FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION DECLARING AN ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THIRD STREET FROM TANGENT STREET NORTH TO MARY STREET.

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2 WHEREAS, On the 16th day of November, 1920, there was filed with
3 the recorder of the City of Lebanon, a Petition duly signed by the
4 owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting
5 upon and the real property specially benefitted thereby asking for
6 the improvement of Third Street from Tangent Street North to Mary
7 street, and

8 WHEREAS, On the said 16th day of November the common council passed
9 and adopted a resolution requiring of the city engineer and street
10 superintendent of streets of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, plans,
11 specification and estimates of the probable total cost of the said
12 improvement as prayed for the said petition, and

13 WHEREAS, On the said 16th day of November, 1920, the said City en-
14 gineer and Street superintendent filed with the recorder their
15 plans, specification and estimates of the probable total cost of
16 the said improvement, which said plans, specification and estimates
17 was duly adopted and ratified by the said council, That the said
18 estimates of the total probable cost of the said improvement as
19 asked for the said petition was and is the sum of \$400.00, and
20 the estimate of the total cost to be paid by the city of Lebanon
21 was the sum of \$56.00 and the estimate of the total probable cost
22 of the said improvement to be paid by the owners of the abutting
23 real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby
24 was the sum of \$344.00. And

25 WHEREAS, the said City by resolution duly adopted and enacted on
26 the said 16th day of November authorized the said work to be done
27 and prayed for the said petition and according the said plans, speci-
28 fications, and estimates, and

29 WHEREAS, The said City engineer and superintendent of streets have
30 made and filed with the recorder their report showing that the said
31 work had been fully done and completed according to the said petition
32 and the plans, specifications and estimates, and that the costs thereof

1 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the recorder of the city of Leb-
2 anon, be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enter
3 up all liens and assessments in the docket of City liens of the City
4 of Lebanon, in the amounts hereinbefore set out and as set out and
5 specified in the said assessment roll so filed by the said City en-
6 gineer and street superintendent insaid matter and according to the
7 provisions of this resolution and the charter and laws of the City
8 of Lebanon,

9 That as soon as this resolution is passed and approved by the Mayor
10 that the said recorder give notice of the said assessment and lien
11 to each owner or reputed owner of the said realproperty as herein
12 described and given of the amount of the said assessment and lien
13 and that the same is payable at once.

14 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the assessment roll submitted by
15 the said City engineer and Street superintendent of streets and
16 attached to their said report be and the same is hereby adopted
17 as the assessment roll for the said improvement and the said street
18 , and the same is hereby in all things ratified and approved, and
19 is hereby declared a lien for the said amounts against the said
20 lots, tracts and parcels of land as therein set out in the said
21 amounts.

22 Adopted by the Council this 7th day of June, 1921, on roll call

24 the journal of the council proceedings; all members elected to the
25 council voting for same.
