

RESOLUTION No. 21. FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY THROUGH BLOCK L# IN RALSTON'S ADDITION TO LEBANON, OREGON.

1 WHEREAS, on the 15th day of March, 1921 there was filed with the
2 recorder of the City of Lebanon, a petition asking for the improve-
3 ment of the alley through Block L# in Ralston's Addition and Ralston's
4 Third Addition from Ash Street North to Vine Street, which said pe-
5 tition was signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the
6 real estate abutting on the said improvement and all the real prop-
7 erty specially benefitted thereby, asking that the said improvement
8 be made without asking for any bids and without any further notice
9 in the matter, and whereas, on the said 15th day of March, 1921, the
10 council of the City of Lebanon passed and adopted a resolution re-
11 quiring of the City engineer and street superintendent of Streets of
12 the said city plans, specification and estimates of the probable to-
13 tal cost of the said improvement, and

14 WHEREAS, on the said 15th day of March, 1921 the said city engineer
15 and street superintendent filed with the recorder of the said city
16 their plans, and specifications and estimates of the probable total
17 cost of the said improvement, which said plans, specifications and
18 estimates was on said 15th day of March 1921 duly approved and
19 ratified and affirmed in all things, and

20 WHEREAS, on the said 15th day of March, 1921 the said city council
21 duly passed and adopted a resolution providing for the said work
22 and authorizing the said city engineer and street superintendent
23 to cause the said to be done and performed according to the said
24 petition and plans and specifications and estimates, and

25 whereas the said city engineer and Street superintendent have
26 filed with the recorder of the said city their report showing
27 that the said work has been fully completed and done according
28 to the said plans, and specifications and according to the said
29 petition asking for same, and that the cost of making the said
30 improvement is less than the estimates therefor, and

31 WHEREAS, the said City engineer and street superintendent have
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1 made and files with the resocred an assessment roll of the said
2 improvement and have therein charged to each separate lot and t
3 tract and parcel of land is just proportion and part of the said
4 improvement, and

5 WHEREAS? IT APPEARS to the council that the said assessment roll
6 is just and correct and that each separate lot and parcel, of
7 land has been assessed and charged its just share and proportion
8 of the said improvement. which said assessment roll and the
9 amount so charged against each separate lot parcel and tract of
10 land is as follows :-

2 sessment roll be declared to be the assessment for the said improvement
3 and that the said several amounts and sum as therein assessed be
4 made and declared a lien against the said lot, tracts and parcels
5 of land as therein described.

6 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the recorder of the city of Lebanon
7 be and he is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to enter up
8 in the Docket of City liens the said several amount and sums against
9 the said lots and tract and parcels of land, and he is further dir-
10 rected to give due notice of the said to the owners and reputed
11 owners as therein given of the said sums and amount and that the
12 same is payable at once. And that he do all other things required
13 by the charter and laws of the said city in such cases.

14 Adopted and passed by the Council on roll call and vote taken by
15 aye and nay vote and entered in the journal of the council proceed-
16 ings, all members elected to the council voting in favor of the
17 said resolution., on this 7th day of June, 1921
