RESOLUTION REQUIRING PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES FOR 1 THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY THROUGH BADOK NO.12 IN RALSTONS 2 ADDITION AND IN ROASTON'S THIRD ADDITION. 3 Thereas, there was filed with the recorder on the 20th day of 4 May, 1921 a petition asking for the improvement of alley through $\mathbf{5}$ Block No. 12 in Ralston's Addition and InRalston's Third Addition 6 same extending from Sharmon street to Ash Street, in Lebanon, 7 Oregon,, and it appearing to the council that the same is signed by 8 all the owners of the real property abutting on the said alley and 9 appearing to the council that it is expedient to make the said im-10 provement,

11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL THAT the 12 council requires of the city engineer and street superintendent 13 plans, specification and estimates of the probable total cost of 14 making the said improvement as prayed for in the said petition now 15 on file for same, which said improvement shall consist of graveling 16 the said alley for a width of 8 feet and to a thickness of 6 inches 17 with crushed gravel and that the alley be graded where needed to 18 allow the water to run off.

That the entire cost of the said improvement be made at the cost and expense of the owners of the said abutting real property the sogners of the said petition.
