

RESOLUTION NO. 22, FOR 1921.

1 RESOLUTION REQUIRING PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ESTIMATES FOR  
2 THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY THROUGH BLOCK NO.12 IN RALSTONS  
3 ADDITION AND IN ROASTON'S THIRD ADDITION.

4 Thereas, there was filed with the recorder on the 20th day of  
5 May, 1921 a petition asking for the improvement of alley through  
6 Block No. 12 in Ralston,s Addition and InRalston,s Third Addition  
7 same extending from Sharmen street to Ash Street, in Lebanon,  
8 Oregon,, and it appearing to the council that the same is signed By  
9 all the owners of the real property abutting on the said alley and  
10 appearing to the council that it is expedient to make the said im-  
11 provement,

12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL THAT the  
13 council requires of the city engineer and street superintendent  
14 plans, specification and estimates of the probable total cost of  
15 making the said improvement as prayed for in the said petition now  
16 on file for same, which said improvement shall consist of graveling  
17 the said alley for a width of 8 feet and to a thickness of 6 inches  
18 with crushed gravel and that the al ey be graded where needed to  
19 allow the water to run off.

20 That the entire cost of the said improvement be made at the  
21 cost and expense of the owners of the said abutting real prop-  
22 erty the sogners of the said petition.

23 That the said plans and specificationand estimates be filed with  
24 the recorder onor before the 7th day of June, 1921.
