

RESOLUTION NO. 23. FOR 1921

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE ALLEY THROUGH
BLOCK 12 IN RALSTON'S ADDITION AND RALSTON'S 3rd ADDITION.

1 WHEREAS, The common council deems it expedient and for the best in-
2 terest of the city of Lebanon to improve the alley thorough block 12
3 in Ralston,s Addition and Ralston's Third Addition to Lebanon, by
4 graveling the road way thereof with crushed gravel for a width of
5 not less than 8 feet and of a thickness of 6 inches, and with at
6 least two layers of gravel. And

7 WHEREAS there is on file with the recorder of the said city a
8 petition duly signed by the owners of all the real property abut-
9 ting on the said pmposed improvement and the real property specially
10 benefitted thereby,, And

11 WHEREAS, The council did on the 7th day of June duly adopt resolu-
12 tion No. 22 for the year 1921 requiring of the city engineer and
13 street superintendent their plans and specifications and the esti-
14 mates of the probable total cost of the said improvement, which
15 said plans and specifications and estimates were filed with the
16 recorder on the 7th day of June, 1921.

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that the said plans,
18 specification and estimates of the total probable cost of the said
19 improvement be and the same is hreby in all things approved, ratified
20 and confirmed.

21 That the said improvement be made as follows:

- 22
23 1st By grading the alley to proper grade.
24 2nd, By graveling the road way of the said alley with crushed
25 gravel for a width of not less than eight feet and to a
26 thickness of 6 inches.
27 3rd by making proper drainage for the alley to keep the woter
28 off the raod way.

29 That the said improvement be made in accordance with the said pe-
30 tition, and the said plans and specifications and in accordance with
31 the charter and ordinances of the cityof Lebanon, Oregon.

32 That the entire cost of the said improvement be paid for by the
owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially
benefitted thereby. That the city engineer and street superintendent

1 have made and filed thier estimates of the total cost of the said
2 improvement, in the sum of \$88.00, which said sum is to be paid by
3 the owners of the abutting real property and real property specially
4 benefitted by said improvement.

5 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That by reason of the said petition
6 the council has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement
7 according to the said petitions and the said plans and specifica-
8 tions and the said estimates. And

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the street superintendent and the
10 City Engineer be and they are hereby authorized and empowered
11 and directed to proceed at once to make or cause to be made the
12 said improvement according to the said petition and the said plans,
13 specifications and the said estimates and that whenthe said work
14 is completed, that they make and file with the recorder their re-
15 port in writing, with the cost thereof, and that they made an assess-
16 ment roll charging to eachseparte lot or tract of lans it just pro-
17 portion of the said cost thereof, not exceeding the estimate for
18 same.

19 Passed by the Cluncil this 7th day of June, 1921, by aye and nay
20 vote of the council taken on roll call, all members elected to the
21 council voting for the said resolution, and the vote entered in
22 the journal of the council proceedings.

23 Approved by the Mayor this 7th day of June, 1921.
