RESOLUTION NO. 27 FOR 1921.

RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF FIFTH STREET WEST OF OAK STREET IN LEBANON, OREGON.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon deems it expedient to improve certian streets inthe city of Lebanon, Oregon. WHEREAS, there is on file with the recorder of the said City of Lebanon, a petition praying for the improvement of the hereinafter mentioned streets, and it appearing to the Council from the said petition that the same is duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the said streets to be improved and the real property specially benefitted thereby, and after due investigation the council finds that the said petition is duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on the said proposed improvement and the real property specially benefitted thereby, And

WHEREAS, The Council did on the 19th day of July, 1921, duly adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the city engineer and the city superintendent of streets, plans and specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvements, which said plans and specifications and estimates were on the 19th day of July, 1921 duly filed with the recorder of the said city.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, that the council deems it expedient and for the best interest of the city of Lebanon to improve the following streets and in the following manner.

1 Beginning at a point 1/2 block South of Oak street and running thence South to a point in Fifth Street West of the N. W. corner of block 46 in Hyland Addition to Lebanon, Oregon.

That the said improvement be made in the following manner.

1st, By grading the roadway of the said streets to a proper subgrade.
2nd, By graveling the roadway of the said street with crushed gravel
for a width of 12 feet and to a thickness of 6 inches, with at least
two layers or coarses of gravel No. 1.
3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

That the said improvement be made and done in accordance with the provisions of Article IV of Chapter VIII of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, and such other provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the State of Oregon, known as the "Bancroft Res. 27 Page 1

Bonding Act" and in accordance with the petition on file asking for
the said improvements and in accordance with the plans and specifications of the city engineer and City Street superintendent filed with
the recorder of the said city on the 19th day of July, 1921, and marked
"Plans and Specifications and Estimates for the Improvement of Fifth
Street West of Oak Street"

That the cost of the grading and drainage of the said streets be done by and paid by the city of Lebanon out of any funds available for that purpose, and that the cost of the graveling and the other costs of the said improvements of the said streets be paid for by the owners of the abutting real porperty and the real property specially benefitted thereby.

That the City Engineer and Street Superintendent of the said city have filed with the recorder of the said city their plans, and specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvements in the sum of \$352.40 and the sum thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon, is the sum of \$50.00 and the sum thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby is the sum of \$302.40.

That the said plans and specifications and the estimates of the probable total cost of the said improvement are hereby in all things approved, ratified and affirmed,

And be it further resolved that there is on file with the recorder of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, in this matter a petition duly signed by the owners of more than a mojority of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement and the real property specially benefitted thereby asking for the said improvement and that the same be made without asking for any bids for same and that no bids be received or had for same and that the city of Lebanon do or cause the same to be one and made and that no further notice be given of the intention to make the same or of the making of the same, and they each and all jointly and severally waive any and all further or additional notices in the matter,

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED that by reason of the said petition and the matters herein set out the city has acquired juris_ Res. 27 Page 2

diction to make the said improvement in accordance with the said petition and the said plans and specifications and the said estimates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the street Superintendent and City Engineer proceed to make the said improvements in accordance with the said petition and the charter of the said city and the laws governing the same, and that they make and file a report in writin when the said work is completed of the work done and the cost thereof to each ; ot and oparcel of land.
