

RESOLUTION NO. 30 FOR 1921.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN J. M. BURTENSCHAW:-

RESOLUTION FIXING TAX LEVY FOR FISCAL YEAR, 1922.
AND ADOPTING BUDGET FOR SAID YEAR

WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY that money and funds be raised to meet the expenditures of the government of the city of Lebanon, for the fiscal year 1922, and to pay the salaries of officers of the said city, and to pay interest on bonded indebtedness, and for lights for streets and for water for fire protection, and other purposes, and for maintaining and improving streets, and for fire protection and for all other purposes of the said city, and

WHEREAS, the Council did heretofore duly appoint a budget Committee composed of the council and six free holders of the said city, who prepared a budget for all expenditures of the said city for the said year, and that due notice of a public meeting to discuss and consider the said budget was duly given and held and at the said public hearing the said budget as submitted was duly approved by the said mass meeting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IN LINN COUNTY, OREGON,

That the following be and the same is hereby adopted as the budget of expenditures for the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1922, and that the several amounts and sums therein named shall be and are hereby appropriated and levied for the several purposes and objects therein named, and are levied against all the taxable property in the said city pro rata according to the assessed valuation thereof by assessor of Linn County, Oregon, which said budget of expenditures for said year is as follows:-


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That No officer or head of any department of the City Government of officer of the said city, shall during the said year 1922, incur or create any debt, liability or obligation on behalf of the said city of Lebanon, Oregon, against any of the said accounts which in the aggregate shall exceed the amounts herein levied and appropriated for his department or office, unless, the Council shall first specially authorize such additional expenditure or liability or obligation, and shall have provided for the payment therefor. And

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be and is hereby levied against all the taxable $\frac{1}{2}$ property within the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, as shown upon and by the assessment roll of said County for the year 1921, now in the office of the Assessment of the said County, a tax sufficient to raise the said sums as herein provided and enumerated and specified in the said sum of \$21,323.00 less the sum of \$649.00 raised by fines and licenses and other sources in the said City, and that the sum to be raised by direct taxation is the sum of \$20,674.00 and also less the sum to be raised by road levy made by Linn County, Oregon, for Road Purposes.

1 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the recorder of the City of Lebanon,
2 Oregon, at once notify the Clerk of Linn County, Oregon, and the
3 Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, in writing of the amount of money here-
4 by required to be raised by direct taxation, by the said City of Lebanon
5 and of this levy therefor, for the said year 1922.
