RESOLUTION NO. 2 FOR 1921.

1 WHEREAS, there was filed with the recorder of the City of Lebanon  
2 Oregon, on the 18th day of January, 1921, a petition praying for  
3 the improvement of the hereinafter mentioned and described street  
4 , and it appearing to the council from the said petition that  
5 the same is signed by the owners of more than a majority of all  
6 the real property abutting on the said proposed improvement, and  
7 after investigation by the council the council finds that the  
8 said petition is signed by the owners of more than a majority  
9 of all the real property abutting thereon, and real property  
10 specially benefitted thereby, and

11 WHEREAS, The Council did on the 1st day of February, 1921 duly  
12 adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the City engineer  
13 and street superintendent of the said city plans and specifica-  
14 tion and estimates of the probable total cost of the said im-  
15 provement, which said plans, specification and estimates were  
16 on the 1st day of February, 1921 filed with the recorder of  
17 the said city,

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City  
19 of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, that the council deems it  
20 expediant and for the best interest of the said city to make  
21 the said improvement, the said improvements to be made on  
22 the following streets and in the manner hereinafter described.

23 PARK STREET from the center line of Iabella Street to the center  
24 line of Carolina Street.

25 CAROLINA STREET from the east line of Main Street to the center  
26 line of Park Street.

27 That the said improvement be made in the following manner,

- 28 1st, By Grading the roadway of the said streets to proper subgrade  
29 2nd, By Graveling the roadway of the said streets for a width  
30 of twelve feet with Crushed gravel and for a thickness  
31 of about 6 inches.  
32 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

That the said improvement be made and done in accordance

1 with the provision of Article IV of Chapter VIII of the  
 2 Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions  
 3 of the said Charter as relates thereto, and of the laws of  
 4 the State of Oregon, known as the "Bancroft Bonding Act" and  
 5 in accordance with the petition filed asking for the said im-  
 6 provement, and in accordance with the plans and specification  
 7 of the city engineer filed with the recorder on the 1st day  
 8 of February, 1921, and endorsed, "Plans for the Improvement of  
 9 PARK-CAROLIAN STREETS"

10 That the cost of the grading the said street be paid by  
 11 the City of Lebanon, Oregon, out of any funds available there-  
 12 for, and that the cost of the graveling and other costs of  
 13 the said improvement be paid by the owners of the real property  
 14 abutting on the said improvement and the real property specially  
 15 benefitted thereby,

16 That the City Engineer and superintendent of Streets of the  
 17 said City have filed with the recorder of the said City their  
 18 plans, specifications and the estimate of the probable total  
 19 cost of the said improvement, in the sum of \$287.60, and the  
 20 sum thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon is the sum of \$ 50.00  
 21 and the sum thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting  
 22 real property and the real property specially benefitted there-  
 23 by in the sum of \$237.60,

24 That the said plans, specifications and estimates of the  
 25 said City engineer and street superintendent are hereby in  
 26 all things ratified and approved and affirmed.

27 That it is hereby further resolved, that there is on file  
 28 herein in this matter a petition duly signed by the owners  
 29 of more than a majority of all the real property abutting on  
 30 the said proposed improvement, asking that the same be made  
 31 without any further notice or the calling for bids for the same  
 32

1 or the giving any further notice of the intention of making  
2 same or the making of the same and they specially waive any and  
3 all further notice in the matter.

4 It It therefore further resolved that the city has acquired  
5 jurisdiction to make the said improvement in accordance with  
6 the said petition and the said plans, and specifications. And  
7 Be It Further resolved that the City Engineer and Street Su-  
8 perintendent proceed to make the said improvements to the  
9 sai streets, in accordance with the said petitions and said  
10 plans and specifications therefor, and report to the Council  
11 when the said work is completed and finished.
