lst, By grading the road way of the said street to proper subgrade 2nd, By graveling the road way of the said street for a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel, and to a depth of 6 inshes with two layers or coarses of gravel. 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

That the improvement of the said streets be made and done in accordance with the provisions of articles IV of Chapter VIII of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws of the state of Oregon, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act.
