

RESOLUTION NO. 4 FOR 1921.

1 WHEREAS there was filed with the recorder of the City of Lebanon
2 on the 18th day of January, 1921, a petition praying for the
3 improvement of the hereinafter mentioned and described streets
4 in the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, State of Oregon, and it
5 appearing to the Council from the said petition and from inves-
6 tigation that the said petition is signed by more than a majority
7 of all the real property abutting upon the said streets and the
8 real property specially benefitted thereby, and

9 WHEREAS, the council did on the 1st day of February, 1921, duly
10 adopt and pass a resolution requiring of the City engineer and
11 superintendent of streets of the said city plans and specifica-
12 tions and estimates of the probable total cost of the said im-
13 provement, which said plans, specifications and estimates were
14 filed with the recorder of the said city on the 1st day of Febru-
15 ary, 1921.

16 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the
17 said City, that the council deems it expedient and for the best
18 interests of the said city to make the said improvements as asked
19 for in the said petition, which said improvement is to be made
20 on the following streets:-

21 SECOND STREET from the center line of Oak street South to city
22 limits.

23 E STREET from the center line of Second Street East to Main
24 street, and to be made as follows:

- 25 1st, By grading the road way of the said street to proper subgrade
26 2nd, By graveling the road way of the said street for a width of
27 12 feet with crushed gravel, and to a depth of 6 inches with
two layers or courses of gravel.
28 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said streets.

29 That the improvement of the said streets be made and done in
30 accordance with the provisions of articles IV of Chapter VIII
31 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and such other
32 provisions of the said charter as relates thereto, and the laws
of the state of Oregon, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act.

1 And in accordance with the said petition asking for the said im-
2 provement, and in accordance with the said plans and specifica-
3 tions filed with the recorder on the 1st day of February, 1921,
4 and Marked and endorsed "Plans and Specifications for the Improve-
5 ment of Second and E Streets."

6 That the cost of the grading and drainage of the said streets
7 be paid by the city of Lebanon out of any funds available for
8 that purpose, and that the graveling and other costs of the
9 said improvement be paid by the owners of the abutting real
10 property and the real property specially benefitted thereby.

11 That the city engineer and Superintendent of streets have
12 filed with the recorder of the said city their plans and es-
13 timate of the probable total costs of the said improvement and
14 that the estimates of the total cost of the said improvement is
15 the sum of \$410.40 and the sum thereof to be paid by the city
16 of Lebanon is the sum of \$50.00, and the sum thereof to be paid
17 by the owners of the abutting real property is the sum of \$360.40

18 That the said plans, specifications and estimates of the
19 total probable cost for the said improvement as filed by the
20 said officers is hereby ratified and approved in all things.

21 And be it further resolved by the council that there is on
22 file with the recorder of the said city a petition duly signed
23 ~~by xxxxxxxxxx~~ by the owners of more than a majority of all the
24 real property abutting on the said improvement and the real prop-
25 erty specially benefitted thereby asking that the said improve-
26 ment be made without advertising for bids for same, and that
27 no bids be received or called for, and that the city of Lebanon
28 make or cause to be made the said improvement, and that no further
29 notice be given of the intention of making the said improvement
30 and they hereby waive any and all other and further notices in
31 the matter.

1 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said city has acquired
2 jurisdiction to make the said improvements in accordance with
3 the said petition and the said plans and specifications, and
4 Be It further resolved that the City engineer and the super-
5 intendent proceed at once to make the said improvements to the
6 said streets in accordance with the said petition and plans and
7 specification and estimates, and that they report to the council
8 in writing when the work is completed.
