RESOLUTION NO. 8 FOR 1922

INTRODUCED BY B. L. COTTON COUNCILMAN.

RESOLUTION FIXING TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1923.
AND ADOPTING BUDGET FOR SAID YEAR.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that money and funds be raised to meet the expenditures of the City government of the city of Lebanon, Oregon for the fiscal year of 1923 and to pay the salaries of the officers of the said city, and to pay interest on the bonded indebtedness of the said city, and for lights for the streets and for water for fire protection and other purposes and the improving and repairing the streets and for all other purposes of the said city government of the said city, and

WHEREAS, the common council did heretofore duly appoint a budget committee consisting of free holders of the said city as by law provided, who prepared and submitted a budget of expenditures for the said city for said year, and caused the same to be published in a local newspaper of the said city as by law required, and a public hearing was had on the same at the City Hall in Lebanon Oregon, on Monday November 20th, 1922, when any legal voters of the said city was given an opportunity to be heard for and against the said budget as submitted, and at said hearing the said budget was by a vote of all those presents at said hearing duly approved and confirmed, in all things and matters.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IN LINN COUNTY, OREGON,

That the following be and the same is hereby adopted as the budget of expenditures for the said city of Lebanon, Oregon, for the fiscal year of 1923, the same being as prepared by the said budget committee and approved by the said meeting, and that the several amounts and sums therein named shall be and are hereby appropriated and levied for the several purposes and objects therein named and set out and the same shall be and are hereby levied against all the taxable property in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, pro rata according to the assessed valuation thereof as made by the assessor of Linn county

State of Oregon, as appears on the said assessment roll of said Linn County, Oregon, which said budget for the said year 1923 is as follows:-

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that No officer or head of any department of the city government or office of the said city shall during the said year 1923, incur or create any debt, liability or obligation on behalf of the said city of Lebanon, against any of the said funds or accounts which in the aggregate shall exceed the amount herein levied and appropriated for his department or office, unless, the council shall first specially authorize such additional expenditure or liability or obligation, and shall have provided for the payment therefor. And

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is hereby levied against all the taxable property within the city of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, as shown upon and by the assessment roll of said county a tax sufficient to raise the said sums as herein provided and enumerated and specified and in the said sum of \$21,900.00. And

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council, That the recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, at once notify the Clerk of Linn County, Oregon, and the Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, in writing of the amount of money hereby required and levied and appropriated to be raised by direct taxation by the said City of Lebanon, for the said year 1923.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted and passed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, by the unanimous vote ~~xxxx~~ of all members elected to the council voting in favor of the same by ~~ayd~~ and nay vote upon the roll call of the Council and the vote being entered in the journal of the council proceedings, this 21st day of November, 1922.
