Resolution # 3. for 1922

RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROSE STREET FROM THE WEST LINE OF WILLIAMS STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF GROVE STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon deem it expedient and for the best interest of the said city to improve certain streets of the said city by grading the same to proper subgrade, and by grading the road way of the said streets with crushed gravel, and MHEREAS, There is a petition on file with the recorder of the said City praying for the improvement of Rose Street from the West line of Williams Street to the East line of Grove Street;

NOW THEREFORE FE IT RESOLVED, That the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, requires of the City Engineer and Street Superintendent of the said City plans, specifications and estimates of the total probable cost for the improvement of the said street as aforesaid and that said improvement be made in the following manner:

- (1.) By Grading the roadway of the said Street to proper subgrade.
- (2.) By Graveling the roadway of the said Street for a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel and for proper thickness to make a good substantial road bed.
- (3.) By making proper drainage for the Street.

That the grading of the said Street and the spreading of the gravel after the same is hauled on the Street be done by and at the expense of the City of Lebanon, and that the same be paid for out of the road or general or other funds of the said City.

That the cost of graveling of the said Street with crushed gravel be done at the expense of the owners of the abutting real property and the real property specially benefitted thereby, and that the same be made a lien and charge against such property. That the said plans and specifications be filed with the Recorder on or before March 6, 1923.
