

RESOLUTION NO. 1, FOR 1923.

IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY IN BLOCK 3.

Whereas, The common council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, deems it expedient and for the best interest of the said City of Lebanon, to improve certain alleys of the said city by grading the same to proper subgrade, and by graveling the roadway of the said alleys for a width of 12 feet with crushed rock of fine river gravel, and Whereas, there is on file with the recorder of the said city a petition asking for the improvement of alley in block 3, city of Lebanon, Oregon, from Grant street to Sherman street, and the Council has found and ascertained that the said petition is signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed and asked for improvement, which said petition asks that the said alleys be improved in the following manner, to wit:

- 1st, By grading the alley to proper subgrade.
- 2nd, By graveling the roadway of said alley to a width of 12 feet with crushed gravel or fine river gravel.
- 3rd, By making proper drainage for said street.

That the grading of said alley be done and paid for by the city of Lebanon, Oregon.

That the graveling of said alley be paid for by the owners of the abutting real property and the owners of the real property specially benefitted thereby and that the said costs thereof be made a charge against and a lien upon the said real property, abutting thereon and real property specially benefitted thereby.

NOW WHEREFORE be it resolved by the Council of the said City that the City of Lebanon requires of the City engineer of the city of Lebanon, plans and specifications for the said above mentioned and proposed street improvement as above mentioned and set out. And that he further submit with the said plans and specifications estimates of the total probable cost of the said improvement, both to be paid by the city and the said abutting owners, and that he file the same with the recorder of the city of Lebanon on or before January 2nd, 1923.

Passed by the Council this 2nd day of January, 1923, by aye and nay vote of the council taken on roll call, and receiving more than three-fourth affirmative vote of all members elected to the council.

Approved by the Mayor this 2nd, day of January, 1923.
