

RESOLUTION NO. 2, 1923

IN THE MATTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALLEY IN BLOCK THREE IN
CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.

WHEREAS on the 2nd day of January, 1923, there was filed with the recorder a petition asking for the improvement of certain alleys as hereinafter provided, and

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of January, 1923, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, passed a resolution No. 1, for 1923, requiring of the city engineer of the said city of Lebanon, plans and specification and the estimates of the probable total costs for the said improvement of the said hereinafter mentioned and described alleys, and

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of January, 1923, the city engineer filed with the recorder his report of his plans and estimates of the probable total costs of the improvement of the said alley,, which said alley is described as follows:

Alley in Block 3, in Lebanon, Oregon, from Grant street to Sherman street, and that said improvement to be made as follows:

- 1st, By grading the said alley to proper subgrade.
- 2nd, By graveling the roadway of said alley not to exceed 12 feet in width with crushed gravel or fine river gravel.
- 3rd, By making proper drainage for the said alleys.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the said plans, specifications and the estimates of the probable total costs be and the same are in all things approved ratified and confirmed. And

Be It Further resolved by the said Council that the said council finds and ascertains from the said report of the said engineer and from the said petition and from examination that the petition filed with the recorder on the 2nd day of January, 1923, asking for the said improvement is duly signed by the owners of more than a majority of all the real property abutting upon the said proposed improvement and the real property specially benefitted thereby, and the said petition asks that the said improvement be made without any further notice to the owners of the abutting real property or the real property specially benefitted thereby, and without advertisement for bids for said improvement, and

Be It Further resolved by the said Council that by reason of the said petition and as provided by Article IV of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the said City has acquired jurisdiction to make the said improvement as prayed for in the said petition, and

Be It Further resolved, that the said City of Lebanon deems it for the best interest and expediant to make the said improvement to the said alley as prayed for, and that the said City proceed to make or cause to be made the said improvement to the said alley as prayed for in the said petition, without any further notice or the advertising of any bids for same, and that the City do the said work, under the direction of the city engineer, superintendent of streets and Committee on streets and public property of the said council.

Passed by the Council this 2nd day of January, 1923, on the roll call of the council, all members of the council voting in favor of the resolution.

Approved by the Mayor this 2nd day of January, 1923.
