RESOLUTION NO. 6 FOR 1925.

A resolution Declaring an Assessment for the improvement of Carolina Street from the center of Park Street extending East to the center of Grove street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

WHEREAS, on the frist day of April, 1924, a petition was filed for the improvement of Carolina Street from the center of Park Street extending East to the center of Grove Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, on the first day of April, 1924, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon duly enacted a resolution requiring the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets of said City to prepare plans, specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of the making of said improvement, as asked for in the said petition, and

whereas, on the 15th day of April, 1924, the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets of said City, filed with the Recorder their plans, specifications and estimates so made of the probable total cost of said improvement and that the estimates so made of the probable total cost of said improvement was the sum of \$175.00 and the estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement to be paid by the City of Lebanon was the sum of \$75.00 and that the estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property especially benefited thereby was the sum of \$100.00, and

WHEREAS, the Council did on the 15th day of April ,1924, duly adopt a resolution ratifying and approving said plans, specifications and estimates of the probable total cost of said improvement and authorizing the work to be done by the City without advertising for bids for the same, as prayed for in said petition, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets have made their report in writing and filed the same with the Recorder of

said City showing that the said improvements have been fully completed according to the said petition and the plans and specifications therefor and that the total cost of making said improvement is the sum of \$117.83 and that the sum to be paid by the City of Lebanon is the sum of \$33.50 and that the sum to be paid by the owners of the abutting neal property is the sum of \$84.33

THEREAS, the report of said improvement as filed by the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets shows that the said improvement did not cost more than the estimate and in no case is the total cost more than the estimate against any lot or tract of land,

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, that the report of the City Engineer and Superintendent of Streets be and the same is hereby ratified, approved, and in all things confirmed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total cost of said improvement of River Street between the South line of Grant Street and the North line of East Oak Street in the City of Lebanon is the sum of 117.83, and that the portion thereof to be paid by the City of Lebanon is the sum of 33.50 and that the portion thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and the real property especially benefited thereby is the sum of 43.3, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the amount assessed to and against each separate lot and tract of land be and the same is hereby fixed as follows:

ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR CAROLINA STRIET FROM THE CENTER OF PARK STREET EXTENDING EAST TO THE CENTER OF GROVE STREET IN LEBANON, OREGON.

Beginning at a point in North line of Carolina Street in Lebanon, Oregon, which is 198 feet and 1 inch West of the West line of Grove Street; running thence West 74 feet; North 92 feet, East 74 feet, South 92 feet to beginning.

No. 2. - Filena Tucker.

Beginning at a point on North line of Carolina Street in Lebanon, Oregon, which is West 123 feet and 5 in. West of the West line of Grove Street; thence West 74 feet and 8 inches, Morth 92 feet, Mast 74 feet and 8 inches, S. 92 feet to the place of beginning.

No. 3. - J. ". Pierpoint.

Beginning at a point in West line of Grove Street, which point is in North line of Carolina Street in Lebanon, Oregon; thence West 123 feet and 5 inches, Worth 92 feet, East to West line of Grove Street South 92 feet to place of beginning,

No. 4. - Mrs. I. J. Leabo.

Beginning at a point in North line of Carolina Street which is West 272 feet and 1 inch, West of Grove Street; thence West 50 feet to East line of Park Street, North 92 feet East 50 feet, South 92 feet to beginning.

Be it further resolved that the assessment roll, submitted by the City Engineer and Street Superintendent and attached to their report of the improvement of said street, be and the same is hereby adopted as the assessment roll for the improvement of said street and the same is hereby, in all things, ratified and approved, and the said assessments are hereby declared a lien against the several tracts, parcels and lots of land therein described, in the amounts therein set out.
