

Resolution No. 7 for 1925.

RESOLUTION REQUIRING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR
THE IMPROVEMENT OF GRANT STREET FROM THE EAST
LINE OF SECOND STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF
THE CITY LIMITS OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY,
OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to improve that part of Grant Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, beginning at the East line of the intersection of Grant and Second Streets and running thence West to the West city limits of said city, and

WHEREAS, in the improvement of said street, the Council deems it expedient and necessary to improve the same from curb line to curb line, and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it expedient, wise and necessary, in the improvement of said street as above specified, to pave the same with either Asphaltic Concrete or Cement Concrete pavement, either of which may or may not be a patented process.

THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the City Engineer of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, or such other competent Engineer as the City Council may select, be and he is hereby authorized, directed and required to prepare and submit to the Council plans, and specifications for an appropriate improvement of said part of said street, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and that two sets of such plans and specifications be submitted, one for Asphaltic Concrete and the other for Cement Concrete pavement, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Engineer commence at once to prepare said plans, specifications and estimates and file the same in the office of the Recorder at an early a date as possible.
