## RESOLUTION NO. FOR 1925.

RESCLUTION REQUIRING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF HIATT STRE T FROM THE NORTH LINE OF ASH STREET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF VINE STREET IN LEBANCH, LINE COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to improve that part of Hiatt Street extending from the North line of Ash Street to the South line of Vine Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHERMAS, the Council deems it expedient and best for the City of Lebanon that said street be improved by grading the same to proper subgrade, and by graveling the same with eithercrushed rock or fine river gravel to the width of twelve feet in the center of said street, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of said city deems it best and expedient for the city of Lebanon to bear a part of the cost and expense of such improvement,

THEREFORE, be it resolved that in the improvement of said street that the city of Lebanon, at its own expense, properly grade said part of said street to the proper subgrade and that the property owners owning property abutting upon said part of said street to be improved, pay for the surfacing of the same with either crushed rock or fine river gravel, and

Be it further resolved that the City Engineer of said City of Lebanon be and he is hereby directed to prepare plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of said street, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof against each separate lot or tract or parcel of land, and the amount thereof to be borne of the and paid by the owners/adjacent and abutting property and of the property specially benefited thereby.

Be it further resolved that said ingineer commence at once to prepare said plans, specifications and estimates and file the same in the office of Recorder as soon as completed.
