

RESOLUTION NO. 16 FOR 1925.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lebanon has heretofore deemed it expedient and necessary and ordered the improvement of the following described street, to-wit:

North Main Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, from the South line of Carolina Street to the North City Limits in the City of Lebanon, Oregon,

by paving said street full width from the South line of Carolina Street to the North line of Academy Street and twenty feet wide from the North line of Academy Street North to the North City Limits, said twenty foot strip to be as near the center as practicable, the same to be paved with either of the following described types of paving, to-wit:

Portland cement concrete pavement, 7" thick;

Portland cement concrete pavement, 6" thick;

Asphaltic concrete pavement, 2" top, 4" crushed rock base;

Warrenite-Bitulithic, 2" top, 4" crushed rock base;

Warrenite-Bitulithic, 1½" top, 2½" Bituminous base;

Warrenite-Bitulithic, 1½" top, 3½" Bituminous base; and

WHEREAS, after due publication of notice for bids upon said proposed work, as required by the ordinances and the charter of the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, bids have been submitted for the performance and completion of said work; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Lebanon deems it best that it will be most advantageous for the people of the city of Lebanon and those owning property particularly and specifically benefited thereby, that such improvement be made by paving said street with Warrenite-Bitulithic 1½" top, 3½" Bituminous base in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared and submitted by Engineer K. A. Sinclair and now on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following described street, to-wit:

North Main Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,
from the South line of Carolina Street to the North
City limits in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, ^{Bituminous}
be paved with *Parrenite Bitulite*. 1 1/2 in Top. 3 1/2 in Base
