RESOLUTION NO. // FOR 1925.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lebanon has heretofore deemed it expedient and necessary and ordered the improvement of the following described street, to-wit:

Grant Street from the East line of Second Street running thence West to the West line of the City Limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,

by paving said street full width from the East line of Grant Street to the West line of the City Limits, with either of the following desp cribed types of paving, to-wit:

Asphaltic concrete 2" top on 4" crushed rock or crushed
gravel base;
Portland cement concrete 6" thick;
Portland cement concrete 7" thick;
Warrenite-Bitulithic, 2" top, 4" crushed rock base;
Warrenite-Bitulithic, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" top, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Bituminous base;
Warrenite-**Bituli**thic, 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" top, 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Bituminous base.

WHEREAS, after due publication of notice for bids upon said proposed work, as required by the ordinances and the charter of the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, bids have been submitted for the performance and completion of said work; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lebanon deems it best, and that it will be most advantageous for the people of the City of Lebanon and those owning property particularly and specifically benefited thereby, that such improvement be made by paving said street with

Warrenite-Bitulithic  $l\frac{1}{2}$ " top with  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Bituminous base in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared and submitted by Engineer K. A. Sinclair and now on file with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon. NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following described

street, to-wit:

Grant Street from the East line of Second Street running thence West to the West line of the City Limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,

be paved with War renite-Bitulithic  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " top with  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " bituminous base.
